- Outreach is ongoing to expand the list, especially minority-owned businesses.

Entertainment

- DJ ayedizzle will run throughout the event.
- Dayton Salsa Project is performing from 1-2 and Luv Locs will close the event from 4:30-6PM
- Entertainment will include cultural representation of dancers from around the world Fillpino Dancers, Turkish dance group, Mystical Motion and others to be named.

Logistics

- Food trucks will be moved to the road, retail vendors on grass areas with their own tents.
- Volunteers will be recruited from schools and community groups to supplement commission support.
- A bounce house will only be added if sponsorship funding is secured.

Budget & Sponsorship

- Food truck vendor fees of \$100 to help outset cost.
- Seeking to find additional external funds

Next Steps

- Premium Blend will work on sound.
- Continue vendor outreach and confirm additional sign-ups.
- Launch coordinated marketing push with staff.
