A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY, CALIFORNIA RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF ORANGE HEALTH CARE AGENCY AND THE CITY OF LA HABRA AND THE CITY OF FULLERTON FOR THE PROVISIONS OF ALTERNATIVE HOUSING FOR COVID-19 RESPONSE SERVICES FOR HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS AND RATIFYING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES OF LA HABRA AND FULLERTON AND KINGDOM CAUSES INC. (DBA CITY NET) FOR QUARTINE MOTEL SHELTER PROJECT

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the City Manager, as the City's Director of Emergency Services, declared a local emergency as authorized by Government Code section 8630 and La Habra Municipal Code section 2.52.060(a)(1) due to COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution 5934 to thereby ratify the declaration of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, conditions to extreme peril to the safety of persons and property continue to exist in the City of La Habra due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, it's imperative to prepare for and respond to suspected or confirmed COVID-19 cases, to make measures to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, and prepare and respond to an increasing number of individuals requiring medical care and hospitalization; and

WHEREAS, if COVID-19 spreads at a rate comparable to the rate of spread in other locations, the number of persons requiring medical care may exceed locally available resources. Controlling outbreaks minimize the risk to the public, maintains the health and safety of the community, and limits the spread of infection in the community and within the healthcare delivery system; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 © states that a City Council shall review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every sixty (60) days until the City Council terminates the emergency; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution 5935 reaffirming the existence of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2020 the City Council adopted Resolution 5955 reaffirming the existence of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, providing opportunities to shelter and quarantine homeless individuals

with COVID-19, showing symptoms or COVID-19 or vulnerable to COVID-19 will help slow the spread of COVID-19

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The City Council of the City of La Habra ratifies the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Orange Health Care Agency and the City of La Habra and the City of Fullerton for the provisions of alternative housing for COVID-19 response services for homeless individuals.

2. The City Council of the City of La Habra ratifies the Agreement between the cities of La Habra and Fullerton and Kingdom Causes, Inc. (dba City Net) for Quarantine Motel Shelter Project.
