Avoid close contact with people who are ill.



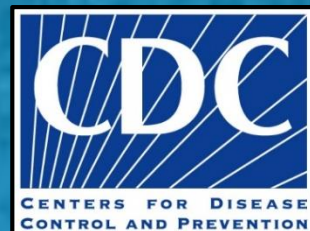
Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
