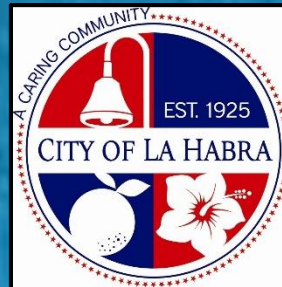
La Habra Vaccination Clinic
