A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA HABRA, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of La Habra are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Habra must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Habra, will receive an estimated \$1,217,375 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2021-2022 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year in which the City of La Habra is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of La Habra to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Habra will be undergoing a public process during the City's Budget adoption to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Habra used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of La Habra maintain and rehabilitate streets/roads throughout the City of La Habra this year and hundreds of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City of La Habra's streets and roads are in a good condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will maintain our streets and roads in a good condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of La Habra does hereby resolve as follows:

- 1) The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 2) The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Project Title: Monte Vista Street Rehabilitation between Lambert Road and La Habra Boulevard

Project Description: The project will reconstruct the asphalt section and new asphalt placed within the full width of the street, reconstruct concrete curb and gutter, reconstruct cross gutters, reconstruct curb ramps, reconstruct sidewalks and alley returns, and place new pavement striping.

Project Location: Monte Vista Street between Lambert Road and La Habra Boulevard.

Estimated Project Schedule: Start (8/21) – Completion (6/22) based on the components being funded with RMRA funds.

Estimated Project Useful Life: The estimated useful life of the pavement will be a minimum of 15 years.

- 3) The following previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of this project in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of La Habra is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Project Title: Annual Arterial Street Rehabilitation Program (Euclid Street from Whittier Boulevard to North City Limits)

Project Description: The project consists of grind and overlay the full width of the street, construct concrete curb barriers, dikes, cross gutters, reconstruction of full depth pavement, damaged curb ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter and pavement striping.

Project Location: Euclid Street from Whittier Boulevard to North City Limits.

Estimated Project Schedule: Start (10/20) – Completion (2/22) based on the components being funded with RMRA funds.

Estimated Project Useful Life: The estimated useful life of the pavement will be a minimum of 15 years.

Project Title: Annual Arterial Street Rehabilitation Program (La Habra Boulevard Rehabilitation from Valley Home Avenue to Beach Boulevard)

Project Description: The project consists of slurry seal the full width of the street, reconstruction of full depth pavement, damaged curb ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and pavement striping.

Project Location: La Habra Boulevard from Valley Home Avenue to Beach Boulevard.

Estimated Project Schedule: Start (10/19) – Completion (10/21) based on the components being funded with RMRA funds.

Estimated Project Useful Life: The estimated useful life of the pavement will be a minimum of 5 years.

Project Title: Annual Arterial Street Rehabilitation Program (Cypress Street from La Habra Boulevard to Whittier Boulevard)

Project Description: The project consists of grind and overlay the full width of the street, reconstruction of full depth pavement, damaged curb ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and pavement striping.

Project Location: Cypress Street from La Habra Boulevard to Whittier Boulevard.

Estimated Project Schedule: Start (10/19) – Completion (10/21) based on the components being funded with RMRA funds.

Estimated Project Useful Life: The estimated useful life of the pavement will be a minimum of 15 years.

Project Title: Annual Arterial Street Rehabilitation Program (Palm Street from La Habra Boulevard to North City Limits)

Project Description: The project consists of grind and overlay the full width of the street, reconstruction of full depth pavement, damaged curb ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and pavement striping.

Project Location: Palm Street from La Habra Boulevard to North City Limits.

Estimated Project Schedule: Start (10/19) – Completion (10/21) based on the components being funded with RMRA funds.

Estimated Project Useful Life: The estimated useful life of the pavement will be a minimum of 15 years.
