**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA HABRA
ADOPTING THE 2020 CITY OF LA HABRA WATER SHORTAGE
CONTINGENCY PLAN**

The City Council of the City of La Habra does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION I:

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources, California Water Code Section 10632, requires that every urban water supplier shall prepare and adopt a Water Shortage Contingency Plan (WSCP) as part of its Urban Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that population and land use growth, climate change, drought, and catastrophic events may occur at any time, and may create water shortages; and

WHEREAS, the City has taken steps to maintain, and reduce the impacts of supply interruptions by adopting a WSCP; and

WHEREAS, the WSCP provides the steps, and water shortage response actions to be taken for each of the six standard water shortage stages ranging from ten percent to fifty percent per Water Code Section 10632 (a)(3)(A); and

WHEREAS, the water shortage stages have been standardized to provide consistent regional and statewide approach to conveying the relative severity of water supply shortage conditions; and

WHEREAS, the WSCP establishes protocols and procedures to communicate identified actions for any current or predicted water shortage condition per Water Code Section 10632 (a)(5); and

WHEREAS, the WSCP identifies procedures for conducting an annual water supply and demand assessment per Water Code Section 10632.1; and

WHEREAS, the WSCP identifies monitoring and reporting requirements to determine customer compliance per Water Code Section 10632(a)(9); and

WHEREAS, as one on MWDOC's 28 member agencies, the La Habra WSCP is designed to be consistent with Metropolitan's Water Shortage and Demand Plan, MWDOC's Water Supply Allocation Plan, and other emergency plans; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Habra is an urban supplier of water in excess of 3,000 customers and/or supplies more than 3,000 acre-feet annually, and has therefore, prepared for public review, a Draft Urban Water Management Plan Update, in compliance with the requirements of AB 797, and a Draft Water Shortage Contingency Plan in compliance with California Water Code Section 10632, and properly noticed a public hearing regarding the Draft Plans that was held by the La Habra Utility Authority of the City of La Habra on June 21, 2021, and continued to July 19, 2021.

SECTION II:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the La Habra City Council as follows:

1. The La Habra 2020 Water Shortage Contingency Plan is hereby adopted; and
2. The Public Works Director is hereby authorized and directed to file the La Habra 2020 Water Shortage Contingency Plan as an appendix to the La Habra 2020 Urban Water Management Plan in compliance with California Water Code Section 10632.
