**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LA HABRA, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF A VETERANS
CEMETERY IN ORANGE COUNTY**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA HABRA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS
FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, in recognition of efforts to plan and construct a proposed veterans cemetery in Orange County on 200 acres of County-owned land located at Gypsum Canyon near the intersection of the 91 Freeway and 241 Toll Road in Anaheim; and

WHEREAS, as a measure of respect for the men and women who served our country in the military and who deserve to be buried close to their homes in Orange County; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2021, individuals and advocates representing veteran organizations gathered at the proposed Orange County Veterans Cemetery site in Anaheim and expressed their support for the Gypsum Canyon location; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, the Orange County Board of Supervisors unanimously approved allocating \$20 million for the development of the veterans' portion of the Mountain Park Cemetery location in Anaheim; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, the Orange County Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted a resolution to move forward with planning and developing a cemetery for veterans in Orange County; and

WHEREAS, the property at Gypsum Canyon has been deeded to the Orange County Cemetery District by the County of Orange for the purpose of building a veterans' cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City of La Habra does hereby support the Orange County Veterans Cemetery in Anaheim Hills, and further encourages federal, state, and local governments to support this much needed project.
