RE: Bid Protest for Annual Sidewalk and Curb Access Ramp Improvements FY 20-21, Project No 3-R-20

Ms. Garcia:

Please consider this our formal bid protest for the above subject project, which bid on October 20, 2021. The results of the bid are as follows:

- Horizons Construction Co. Int'l, Inc. - \$271,990.00 – low bidder
- Vido Samarzich, Inc. \$278,208.00 – second low bidder
- FS Contractors - \$281,166.00 – third low bidder

After requesting and reviewing the bid documents of the low bidder, Horizons Construction CO. Int'l, Inc. (Horizons), it is apparent that Horizons' bid is non-responsive. Regarding bid proposals, the Instructions to Bidders clearly state:

"When presented, they must be completely made out in the manner and form indicated therein, showing the proposed prices clearly and legibly and must be properly signed by the bidder."

Horizons' bid proposal was not completely made out as they failed to include page D-3 of the proposal with their bid. Due to page D-3 being the signature page of the proposal, it is clear that their proposal was not properly signed by the bidder, as the signature was missing along with page D-3 in its entirety. Horizons' submitted an incomplete bid.

The Special Provisions, Section 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS defines a "BIDDER" as:

"Any individual, firm or corporation submitting a bid to furnish the materials and equipment and perform the work herein specified, properly made out on the form furnished by the City Engineer, duly executed by the bidder and enclosed within a sealed envelope directed to the City Clerk, Civic Center, 110 E. La Habra Blvd., La Habra, California 90631."

It appears that by Horizons' not having a signature included with their proposal, they do not even meet the definition of a "BIDDER" as defined in the project specifications.

It is for these reasons that we respectfully request that the City find Horizons' bid non-responsive and award the contract for this project to the second low bidder, our firm, Vido Samarzich, Inc.
