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AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES

This Agreement is made and entered into this 26th day of March, 2007, by and between **THE CITY OF LA HABRA**, (hereinafter referred to as "**CITY**"), and **Nationwide Environmental Services**, a division of Joe's Sweeping, Inc., a California corporation (hereinafter referred to as "**CONTRACTOR**"), to be performed in the City of La Habra.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, **CITY** requires street sweeping services for City streets in order to comply with federal and state clean water requirements (NPDES) and to provide streets that are clean and free of debris; and

WHEREAS, **CONTRACTOR** represents that it is qualified and experienced to provide such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and conditions herein contained, **CITY** and **CONTRACTOR** hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I
SCOPE OF SERVICES; WARRANTY; TERM

1.1 General Scope of Services and Warranty.

- A. **CITY** hereby engages **CONTRACTOR**, and **CONTRACTOR** hereby accepts such engagement, to perform the services set forth in Exhibit "A" (the documents contained in Exhibit "A" shall be hereinafter referred to as the "Scope of Work").

- B. **CONTRACTOR** warrants that it shall perform the services required by this Agreement in compliance with the federal and California laws related to minimum hours and wages, including, but not limited to, 40 U.S.C.A. §§ 3141, et seq., California Labor Code, § 1171, et seq., and California Labor Code, §§ 6300, et seq.; fair employment practices, including but not limited to, 29 U.S.C. 651, et seq.; and fair employment, including, but not limited to, 29 U.S.C. 201, et seq., the California Fair Employment and Housing Act California Government Code § 12900, et seq., Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, 49 CFR 21 through appendix H and 23 CFR 710.405 (b); and all other federal, state and local laws and ordinances applicable to the work required under this Agreement.

1.2 Non-Exclusive Agreement.

CONTRACTOR acknowledges that **CITY** may enter into agreements similar to this Agreement with other contractors.

1.3 Term.

The term of this Agreement shall begin on March 6, 2007 and continue until June 30, 2013. This Agreement may be renewed twice, each for a two-year period, upon mutual agreement by both **CITY** and **CONTRACTOR**.

ARTICLE II
RESPONSIBILITIES OF CONTRACTOR

2.1 Control and Payment of Subordinates.

All personnel to be utilized by **CONTRACTOR** in the performance of this Agreement shall at all times be under **CONTRACTOR'S** exclusive direction and control. **CONTRACTOR** shall pay all wages, salaries, and other amounts due such personnel in connection with their performance of services under this Agreement and as required by law. **CONTRACTOR** shall be responsible for all reports and obligations with respect to such personnel, including, but not limited to social security taxes, income tax withholding, unemployment insurance, and workers' compensation insurance.

2.2 Conformance to Applicable Requirements.

All services provided by **CONTRACTOR** shall be subject to the approval of **CITY**.

2.3 Accounting Records.

CONTRACTOR shall maintain complete and accurate records with respect to costs and expenses incurred in the performance of this Agreement. All such records shall be clearly identifiable as being associated with this Agreement. **CONTRACTOR** shall allow an authorized representative of **CITY**, during normal business hours, to examine, audit, and make transcripts of copies of such records. **CONTRACTOR** shall allow **CITY** to inspect all work, data, documents, proceedings, activities and equipment related to performance of this Agreement for a period of three (3) years from the date of final payment (or completion of work) under this Agreement.

ARTICLE III
COMPENSATION

3.1 Compensation.

Except as provided in this section, **CONTRACTOR** shall receive compensation for all Services rendered under this Agreement at the annual rates set forth in the "Schedule of Rates" attached hereto as Exhibit "B", and incorporated herein by reference. **CONTRACTOR** shall not receive compensation for any services provided outside the "Scope of Work" unless such additional services (hereinafter "Extra Work") are approved in writing by **CITY** or its appointed representative prior to **CONTRACTOR** performing the "Extra Work".

3.2 Payment of Compensation.

CONTRACTOR shall provide **CITY** an itemized monthly statement from March 26, 2007, or the start of the subsequent billing periods, as appropriate, through the date of the statement. **CITY** shall make any payment due within forty-five (45) days after approval of the invoice by **CITY**.

ARTICLE IV INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE

4.1 Insurance Requirements.

CONTRACTOR shall procure and maintain throughout the duration of this Agreement, insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of this Agreement by **CONTRACTOR**, its agents, representatives, employees or consultants. **CONTRACTOR** shall provide current evidence of the required insurance in a form acceptable to **CITY** and shall provide replacement evidence for any required insurance which expires prior to the expiration or termination of this Agreement.

Nothing in this Section shall be construed as limiting in any way, the Indemnification and Hold Harmless clause contained in Section 4.7 of this Agreement, or the extent to which **CONTRACTOR** may be held responsible for payments of damages to persons or property.

A. Minimum Scope and Limits of Insurance.

1) Comprehensive General Liability Insurance to include products, completed operations, contractual liability, and independent contractors. **CONTRACTOR** shall maintain comprehensive general liability insurance or an equivalent form with a limit of not less than \$2,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall

apply separately to this Agreement or shall be twice the required occurrence limit.

2) **Automobile Liability Insurance.** **CONTRACTOR** shall maintain automobile liability insurance or an equivalent form with a limit of not less than \$2,000,000 per accident for bodily injury and property damage. Such insurance shall include coverage for owned, hired and non-owned automobiles.

3) **Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Insurance.** **CONTRACTOR** shall maintain workers' compensation insurance as required by the State of California and employers' liability insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident.

4.2. Deductibles and Self-insured Retentions

Any deductibles or self-insured retentions must be declared to and approved by the CITY. At the option of the CITY, either: the insurer shall reduce or eliminate such deductibles or self-insured retentions as respects the CITY, its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers, or the **CONTRACTOR** shall provide a financial guarantee satisfactory to CITY guaranteeing payment of losses and related investigations, claims administration and defense expense.

4.3 Other Insurance Provisions.

A. The general liability and automobile liability policies are to contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions:

1) **CITY, its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers** are to be covered as additional insureds with respect to liability arising out of automobiles owned, leased, hired or borrowed by or on behalf of the **CONTRACTOR**; and with respect to liability arising out of work or operations performed by or on behalf of **CONTRACTOR** including materials, parts or equipment furnished in connections with such work or operations. Coverage shall not extend to any indemnity coverage for the active negligence of the additional insured in any case where an agreement to indemnify the additional insured would be invalid under Civil Code § 27882(b). General liability coverage can be provided in the form of an endorsement to **CONTRACTOR'S** insurance, or as a separate owner's policy.

2) For any claims related to this project, **CONTRACTOR'S** insurance coverage shall be primary insurance as respects to **CITY, its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers.** Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by **CITY, its officers, officials, employees, agents or**

volunteers shall be excess to **CONTRACTOR'S** insurance and shall not contribute with it.

3) Each insurance policy required by this clause shall be endorsed to state that **CITY** shall receive not less than thirty (30) days prior written notice of cancellation of any policies of insurance required hereunder.

B. Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Coverages. The workers' compensation and employers' liability policies shall be endorsed to state that the insurer agrees to waive all rights of subrogation against **CITY**, its elected officials, officers, employees, and volunteers for losses arising from the operation of **CONTRACTOR** in the performance of this Agreement.

4.4. Acceptability of Insurers.

Insurance is to be placed with insurers authorized to do business by the Insurance Commissioner in the State of California with a BEST's rating of no less than B+ Class X. All insurers shall be licensed by or holding admitted status in the State of California. At the sole discretion of **CITY**, insurance provided by non-admitted or surplus carriers of proven reputation and minimum BEST's rating of no less than A- Class X may be accepted if **CONTRACTOR** evidences the need to the sole satisfaction of **CITY**.

4.5. Verification of Coverage.

CONTRACTOR shall furnish **CITY** with original certificates and amendatory endorsements effecting coverage required by **CITY**. The endorsements should be on forms provided by **CITY** or on other than **CITY'S** forms, provided those endorsements or policies conform to the requirements. All certificates and endorsements are to be received and approved by **CITY** within 30 days of the effective date of this Agreement. **CITY** reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, including endorsements affecting the coverage required by these specifications at any time.

4.6. Sub-contractors:

CONTRACTOR shall include all sub-contractors as insureds under its policies or shall furnish separate certificates and endorsements for each subcontractor. All coverage for sub-contractors shall be subject to all of the requirements stated herein.

4.7. Indemnification and Hold Harmless.

CONTRACTOR shall defend, indemnify, hold free and harmless **CITY**, its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers from and against any and all

damages to property or injuries to or death of any person or persons, and shall defend, indemnify, save and hold harmless **CITY**, its officers, officials, employees, agents and volunteers from any and all claims, demands, suits, actions or proceedings of any kind or nature, including, but not by way of limitation, all civil claims, workers' compensation claims, and all other claims resulting from or arising out of the acts, errors or omissions of **CONTRACTOR**, its employees and/or authorized sub-consultants, whether intentional or negligent, in the performance of this Agreement.

4.8 Additional Insurance.

Further, **CONTRACTOR** shall obtain any additional kinds and amounts of insurance which, in its own judgment, may be necessary for the proper protection of any of its officers', employees', or authorized sub-consultants' own actions during the performance of this Agreement.

4.9 Notice of Policy Changes.

A. All Coverages. Unless **CONTRACTOR'S** insurer agrees to provide thirty (30) days written notice of any changes or modifications to any policies as required in this Agreement, **CONTRACTOR** shall provide copies of all required policies or certificates of insurance as may be requested by **CITY** to establish that such policies have not been modified or reduced in coverage or in limits.

ARTICLE V TERMINATION

5.1 Notice of Termination.

CITY may terminate the whole or any part of this Agreement at any time with cause by giving thirty (30) days written notice to **CONTRACTOR** of such termination, and specifying the effective date thereof. **CONTRACTOR** shall discontinue all services affected by such termination within thirty (30) days of receipt of such notice, unless otherwise instructed by **CITY** in writing. **CONTRACTOR** shall not terminate this Agreement except for cause.

5.2 Termination for Cause.

Should **CONTRACTOR** default in the performance of any covenant, condition, or agreement contained in this Agreement and the default is not cured within fifteen (15) days after written notice of the default is served on **CONTRACTOR** by **CITY** then **CITY**, in addition to any other remedies at law or equity, may terminate this Agreement. **CONTRACTOR** shall be compensated for services which have been completed and accepted by **CITY**. **CONTRACTOR**

shall be liable to **CITY** for any reasonable additional costs incurred to correct or cure unsatisfactory work or services performed by **CONTRACTOR**.

5.3 Procurement of Similar Services.

In the event this Agreement is terminated as provided by this Article, with or without cause, in whole or in part, **CITY** may procure any and all services as may be necessary to complete the work or services.

ARTICLE VI GENERAL PROVISIONS

6.1 Notices.

All notices and written communications sent by one party to the other shall be personally delivered or sent by registered or certified U.S. Mail postage prepaid, return receipt requested to the following addresses indicated below:

The effective date of any notice or written communications sent by one party to the other shall be the date received if by personal service, or 48 hours after deposit in the U.S. Mail as reflected by the official U.S. postmark.

6.2 Entire Agreement.

This Agreement contains the entire Agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, or agreement whether verbal or written, concerning the same subject matter. This Agreement may be modified only by a writing signed by both parties.

6.3 Successors and Assigns.

This Agreement shall be binding on the successors and assigns of the parties. This Agreement may not be sold, transferred or assigned by either party, or by operation of law, to any other person or persons or business entity,

without the other party's written permission. Any such sale, transfer or assignment, or attempted sale, transfer or assignment without written permission, may be deemed by the other party to constitute a voluntary termination of this Agreement and this Agreement shall thereafter be deemed terminated and void.

6.4 Subcontracts.

CONTRACTOR shall not subcontract any portion of the work required by this Agreement without prior written approval of **CITY**. All approved subcontracts, if any, shall be accomplished by a written instrument. Such instrument shall contain an expressed assumption by the subcontractor of all conditions and terms and covenants contained in this Agreement.

6.5 Equal Opportunity Employment.

CONTRACTOR represents that it is an equal opportunity employer and shall not discriminate either directly or indirectly against an employee or applicant for employment with **CONTRACTOR** on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, sexual preference, sex or age. **CONTRACTOR** shall also take affirmative steps to ensure that applicants are employed and employees are treated during employment without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, sexual preference, sex, age, or other prohibited grounds.

6.6 Attorney's Fees.

If either party commences a legal action against the other party arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, the prevailing party in such litigation shall be entitled to have and recover reasonable attorney's fees and costs of suits.

6.7 Governing Law.

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed with the laws of the State of California. Any Action to enforce the terms of this Agreement or for the breach thereof shall be brought and tried in the County of Orange.

6.8 Time of Essence.

Time is of the essence for each and every provision of this Agreement.

6.9 Right to Employ Other Contractors.

CITY reserves the right to employ other contractors in connection with this service.

6.10 Covenant Against Contingent Fees.

CONTRACTOR warrants that he/she/it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working with **CONTRACTOR**, to solicit or secure this Agreement, and that he/she/it has not paid or agreed to pay any company or person, other than a bona fide employee, any fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gift, or any other consideration, contingent upon or resulting from the award or making of this Agreement. For breach or violation of this warranty, **CITY** shall have the right to annul this Agreement without liability, or, in its discretion to deduct from **CONTRACTOR'S** compensation provided under this Agreement, or otherwise recover, the full amount of such fee, commission, percentage, brokerage fee, gift, or contingent fee.

6.11 Conflict of Interest.

CONTRACTOR covenants that it presently has no interest and shall not acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of its Services hereunder. **CONTRACTOR** further covenants that in the performance of this Agreement, no person having any such conflict of interest shall be employed by **CONTRACTOR**.

6.12 Statement of Economic Interest.

If **CITY** determines **CONTRACTOR** comes within the definition of **CONTRACTOR** under the Political Reform Act (Government Code §87100 et. seq.), **CONTRACTOR** shall complete and file and shall require any other person doing work under this Agreement, to complete and file a "Statement of Economic Interest" with the City Clerk of the **CITY** disclosing **CONTRACTOR** and/or such other person's financial interests.

6.13 No Waiver of Breach; Time.

No waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be effective unless in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of the party against whom enforcement of a waiver is sought referring expressly to this Paragraph. The waiver of any right or remedy in respect to any occurrence or event shall not be deemed a waiver of any right or remedy in respect to any other occurrence or event, nor shall any waiver constitute a continuing waiver.

6.14 Third Party Beneficiaries.

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed to create and the parties do not intend to create any rights in third parties.

6.15 Taxes.

CONTRACTOR agrees to file tax returns and pay all applicable taxes on amounts paid pursuant to this Agreement and shall be solely liable and responsible to pay such taxes and other obligations, including, but not limited to, state and federal income and FICA taxes. **CONTRACTOR** agrees to indemnify and hold **CITY** harmless from any liability which it may incur to the United States or to the State of California as a consequence of **CONTRACTOR'S** failure to pay, when due, all such taxes and obligations.

6.16 Compliance With Law.

CONTRACTOR shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations affecting **CONTRACTOR** and its work hereunder.

6.17 Validity.

The validity in whole or in part of any provision of this Agreement shall not void or affect the validity of any other provisions of this Agreement.

6.18 Headings.

Section and subsection headings are not to be considered part of this Agreement, are included solely for convenience, and are not intended to modify or explain or to be a full or accurate description of the content thereof.

6.19 Counterparts.

This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts by the parties hereto. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one agreement.

6.20 Corporate Authority.

The persons executing this Agreement on behalf of the Parties hereto warrant that they are duly authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of said Parties and that by doing so, the Parties hereto are formally bound to the provision of this Agreement.

6.21 Independent Contractor.

The Parties hereto acknowledge and agree that the relationship between **CITY** and **CONTRACTOR** is one of principal and independent contractor and no other. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall create or be construed as creating a partnership, a joint venture, employment relations, or any other relationship as set forth between the parties. The parties specifically

The persons executing this Agreement on behalf of the Parties hereto warrant that they are duly authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of said Parties and that by doing so, the Parties hereto are formally bound to the provision of this Agreement.

6.21 Independent Contractor.


The Parties hereto acknowledge and agree that the relationship between CITY and CONTRACTOR is one of principal and independent contractor and no other. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall create or be construed as creating a partnership, a joint venture, employment relations, or any other relationship as set forth between the parties. The parties specifically acknowledge and agree that CONTRACTOR is not a partner with the CITY, whether general or limited, and no activities of CITY or CONTRACTOR or statements made by CITY or CONTRACTOR shall be interpreted by any of the Parties hereto as establishing any type of business relationship other than an independent contractor relationship.

EXHIBIT "A"

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Sweepers.

A. **CONTRACTOR** shall conduct sweeping with two (2) newly acquired Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) twin engine regenerative air sweepers with all standard equipment. The equipment shall comply with the South Coast Air Quality Management District's (AQMD) adopted Rule 1186.1 – Less Polluting Sweepers. A minimum of two (2) primary sweepers and one (1) back-up sweeper shall be provided with the primary sweepers being used exclusively for the **CITY**.

B. The primary sweepers shall have installed an "active" or "passive" Global Positioning System (GPS) that will enable **CONTRACTOR** and **CITY** to view, via computer, equipment location at all times. The GPS must be able to track non-sweeping stops and speed of the equipment and be able to generate reports and maps with an exact description of services. Data collected shall be provided to **CITY** on a daily basis or other schedule mutually agreed upon by **CONTRACTOR** and **CITY**.

C. Sweepers shall be maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and to the **CITY'S** satisfaction. Each sweeper shall be completely refurbished and repainted no less than once every five (5) years. **CITY** reserves the right to inspect sweepers and **CONTRACTOR'S** physical operations on an annual basis to ensure proper maintenance of equipment and sweepers.

2. Sweeping Procedures

A. **CONTRACTOR** shall operate two sweepers per day, five days per week in accordance with the City's Street Sweeping schedule as identified in Exhibit "C" including, but not limited to residential streets, alleys, commercial and industrial streets, City-owned parking lots, state highways, City arterial streets, curbs, gutters, and medians and islands with or without curbs. All sweeping must be consistent with **CITY** posted signage and to **CITY** specifications, which may include varying start times for different types of areas. **CITY** refuse hauler holidays will be observed. **CITY** reserves the right to adjust the Street Sweeping schedule identified in Exhibit "C" at any time with written notice to **CONTRACTOR**.

B. Sweeping shall be conducted by personnel adequately trained in sweeper operation. **CONTRACTOR** shall designate the same operators to sweep in the **CITY** on a permanent, regular basis. If there is an operator change, **CONTRACTOR** will notify **CITY** within 24 hours. All operators will be required to speak fluent English.

C. Sweepers may be followed by a citation car. In the event that the citation car stops to issue a citation, the sweeper shall slow or temporarily stop its operations, in order to allow the citation car to follow the sweeper. However, under no circumstances shall the sweeper fall more than sixty (60) minutes behind schedule in a single day.

D. Sweeper operators must have cellular telephones or other appropriate communication devices to maintain contact with citation vehicles at all times.

E. **CONTRACTOR** shall dispose of all collected debris and refuse at the **CITY'S** City Yard facility located at 621 W. Lambert Road, La Habra, in accordance with procedures set forth by **CITY**. **CITY** is responsible for disposal of said debris and refuse to a legally established disposal site. **CONTRACTOR** shall not charge **CITY** for any disposal costs in any way.

F. The **CITY'S** Public Works Department shall be notified immediately in the event of a hydraulic oil or other vehicle-related lubricant spill, and such spills shall be cleaned up immediately by **CONTRACTOR**.

G. During rain or inclement weather, sweepers may not be able to operate. However, in such event, sweeper operators shall notify the Public Works Department prior to leaving **CITY** limits.

3. Special Events and Callouts

A. **CONTRACTOR** shall provide sweeping services outside of the Street Sweeping Schedule on Exhibit "C" on an as-needed basis a maximum of twelve (12) times per year during regular sweeping hours, and an additional six (6) times per year outside of regular sweeping hours.

B. In addition to those sweeping services in 3.A. above, **CONTRACTOR** shall provide sweeping services for special community events a maximum of ten (10) times per year, not to exceed a total of sixty (60) sweeping hours. Community events are selected at the sole discretion of **CITY**, and **CITY** shall provide forty-eight (48) hour notice to **CONTRACTOR** of such events when possible.

EXHIBIT "B" SCHEDULE OF RATES

A. Annual Contract. CONTRACTOR agrees to provide all services specified in this Agreement and its Exhibits for the costs below. Annual costs include all costs associated with providing the services herein, including, but not limited to, staffing, equipment, supplies, capital outlay, facilities, insurance and overhead. The annual cost includes 22,920 gallons of fuel per year. Additional fuel charges will be based on Section B of this Exhibit outlined below. The annual charges to the CITY are as follows, and there shall be no adjustment to these charges any time during the term of this Agreement.

B. Fuel Charges. The annual contract costs include fuel costs for 22,920 gallons per year. As of the effective date of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR is paying \$1.55 per gallon at Clean Energy fueling facilities. CONTRACTOR and CITY agree that, should the price of fuel purchased by the CONTRACTOR increase to \$2.10 per gallon or more, known as the "Fuel Threshold", CITY shall pay the difference between \$2.10 and the actual cost of fuel. Each year, the Fuel Threshold shall increase 2.5 percent per year over the previous year's Fuel Threshold. CONTRACTOR shall not charge, invoice or pass along to CITY any fuel costs below the Fuel Threshold.

CONTRACTOR shall invoice CITY, and CITY shall pay CONTRACTOR for actual fuel costs above the Fuel Threshold not to exceed 1,910 gallons per month. Valid original documentation of CONTRACTOR'S actual purchase price of fuel and number of gallons used by sweepers in the CITY, fueling location(s) and the Clean Energy Index for the Orange County area shall accompany such

invoice. **CONTRACTOR** shall not charge, invoice or pass along to **CITY** any costs for fuel in excess of 1,910 gallons per month.

In the event that the **CITY's** fueling charges equal \$12,000 or more in any given year, **CONTRACTOR** shall fuel sweepers used in the **CITY** at the **CITY'S** City Yard facility, and such fueling shall begin immediately upon notification by **CITY**. Notwithstanding the above, **CITY** may request **CONTRACTOR** to fuel sweepers at the City Yard if there are three (3) consecutive months of increases.

C. Additional Hours. Any additional hours above and beyond the scope of services or above and beyond the regular schedule, callouts and community events as described in this Agreement shall be available at the hourly rate of \$85.00 per hour and at a two hour minimum.

EXHIBIT "C"

STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE

CONTRACTOR shall operate two sweepers per day, five days a week. Sweeping shall be performed on residential streets, alleys, commercial and industrial streets, City-owned parking lots, state highways, City arterial streets, curbs, gutters, and medians and islands with or without curbs. The attached schedule identifies the Residential Streets only and does not negate the requirement for **CONTRACTOR** to provide sweeping on alleys, commercial and industrial streets, City-owned parking lots, state highways, City arterial streets, curbs, gutters, and medians and islands with or without curbs.

All sweeping must be consistent with **CITY** posted signage and to **CITY** specifications, which may include varying start times for different types of areas. **CITY** refuse hauler holidays will be observed. **CITY** reserves the right to adjust this Street Sweeping schedule at any time with written notice to **CONTRACTOR**.
