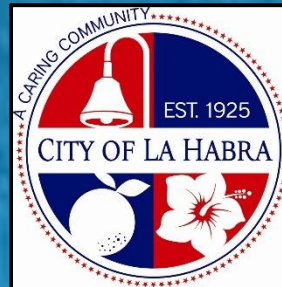

Water Conservation – Do Your Part to Protect Our Resources

Drought conditions mean water conservation mandates are now in effect!

- Irrigation limited to 3x/week (odd addresses = Mon, Wed, Fri and even addresses = Tue, Thu, Sat)
- Limit irrigation to no more than 15 minutes/station with no runoff
- No lawn irrigation between 9a-6p
- No washing of hard surfaces, such as sidewalks/driveways
- Use of potable water for irrigation of non-functional, ornamental turf prohibited at commercial, industrial, and institutional sites

The City of La Habra has established the Small Business Assistance Program (SBAP) to assist small businesses in their economic recovery as a result of the negative impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. SBAP would provide assistance that could be used for a variety of business expenses including payroll and benefits costs, costs of retaining employees, and operating costs, such as mortgage, rent, and utilities.

The program provides grants of up to \$10,000 to eligible businesses to respond to the negative impact of COVID-19. The City has made an initial allocation of \$300,000 to fund this program.

Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis beginning August 1, 2022, until funds are exhausted.
