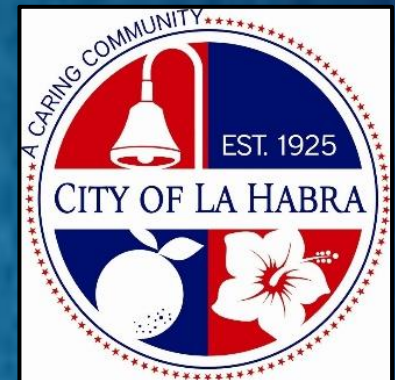

Water Conservation – Do Your Part to Protect Our Resources

Drought conditions mean water conservation mandates are now in effect!

- Irrigation limited to 1x/week
- Odd numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Tuesdays
- Even numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Thursdays
- Limit irrigation to no more than 15 minutes/station with no runoff
- No lawn irrigation between 10a-4p
- No washing of hard surfaces, such as sidewalks/driveways
- Use of potable water for irrigation of non-functional, ornamental turf prohibited at commercial, industrial, and institutional sites
