What is household hazardous waste?

Household hazardous waste (HHW) is any type of household product that requires special handling under environmental law and prohibits disposal as regular waste (trash).

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Hazardous Waste:

- Paint and painting supplies – latex, oil based, thinners, strippers, stains, and finishes
- Automotive products – oil, antifreeze, brake and transmission fluid, automotive batteries
- Cleaning products – drain cleaner, oven cleaner, pool chemicals, bathroom cleaners
- Pesticides, herbicides – bug sprays, mouse and rat poison/bait, repellents
- Propane tanks
- Aerosol cans

- Medications – unwanted/expired, non-controlled.
- Sharps, needles, syringes: **Note: Sharps must be placed in puncture-proof container. Keep in the front seat of the car near you.**

Universal and other special waste:

- Electronics - TVs, computer monitors, laptops, stereo equipment, DVD players, handheld electronics, cell phones, cameras, printers, scanners, fax
- Household batteries (AAA, AA, C, D, 9-volt)
- Fluorescent tubes and bulbs (package to prevent breakage in transport)
- Thermostats, thermometers
- Tires – maximum 9 tires per household. Tires only - no rims accepted.

Items Not Accepted:

- Asbestos
- Biological Waste
- Business waste
- Fire extinguishers
- High pressure cylinders
- Explosives, ammunition, road flares
- Medical Waste
- General waste, bulky items (trash, recycling, furniture, mattresses)
- White goods (stoves, ovens, water heaters, refrigerators)

PREPARATION

- It is illegal to transport more than 15 gallons or 125 pounds of hazardous waste in your vehicle (Department of Transportation requirement).
- Do not mix products together.
- Materials should be in original containers, clearly labeled.
- All containers must have lids, be sturdy, non-leaking, labeled and protected from breakage.
- Containers larger than 5 gallons will not be accepted.



DOCUMENT SHREDDING

Help prevent identity theft and protect the environment by shredding your confidential documents. There is a limit of ten boxes per car. Shredding is available during the hazardous waste collection event. **Keep shredding separate from hazardous waste and batteries.**

Year-Round HHW Program Orange County residents can use the free permanent drop off centers operated by the County of Orange and available year round for proper disposal of hazardous waste. The center located nearest La Habra is at 1071 N. Blue Gum Street Anaheim, CA 92806. 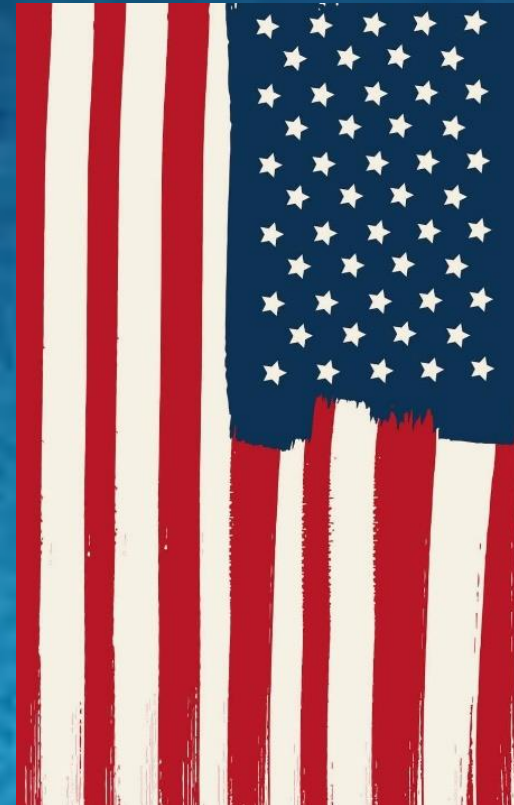

Water Conservation – Do Your Part to Protect Our Resources

**Please do your part and
conserve water!**

- ❖ Irrigation limited to 3x/week.
- ❖ Odd numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- ❖ Even numbered addresses are limited to irrigating on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.
- ❖ Limit irrigation to no more than 15 minutes/station with no runoff.
- ❖ No lawn irrigation between 10 am-4 pm.
- ❖ No washing of hard surfaces such as sidewalks/driveways.
- ❖ Use of potable water for irrigation of non-functional, ornamental turf prohibited at commercial, industrial, and institutional sites.
