

RESOLUTION NO. CC 2024-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA HABRA, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of La Habra, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. CC 2024-09 adopted June 3, 2024, the Orange County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA HABRA, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the number of vote center ballots cast in the City was 6,083. That the vote-by-mail ballots cast in the City was 18,529, making a total of 24,612 ballots cast in the City.

SECTION 2. That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that:

Daren Nigsarian was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; and

Rose Espinoza was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; and,

Delwin "Del" Lampkin was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years.

SECTION 5. That the measure voted upon in the election was as follows:

MEASURE V

City of La Habra Emergency Services/Neighborhood Safety/Community Protection Measure. To help prevent additional cuts to firefighter/paramedic 911 response services; police staffing/ ambulance services; maintain street repairs; protect groundwater supplies, parks/open space; address homelessness; remove hazardous waste; gang prevention; and general City services, shall an ordinance reauthorizing La Habra's existing local sales tax at an updated 1¢ rate be adopted, providing approximately \$15,600,000 annually until ended by voters, requiring audits, public spending disclosure, all funds local?

SECTION 6 The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election a majority of voters voting on Measure V did vote in favor of it and that the measure passed.

MEASURE V

Ballots with Yes Votes 15,876

Ballots with No Votes 7,158

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election as set forth in "Exhibit A", showing: (1) The total number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) the measure voted upon; (4) for what office each person was voted for; (5) the number of election day Vote Center and Vote-By-Mail ballots cast to each person and for and against the measure; and (6) the total number of votes given to each person and for and against the measure.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 9. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
