WHEREAS, her outstanding work has not gone unnoticed, having been featured in five newspaper articles and interviewed on KTLA for several notable exhibits, elevating the Museum's profile and bringing well-deserved recognition to her efforts; and

WHEREAS, Lisa's exceptional service has been honored through numerous awards from the City of La Habra, including: Part-Time Employee of the Year, Proclamation of Commendation, Customer Service Award, Outstanding Recognition Award, Community Services Special Recognition Award, and Certificate of Appreciation.
