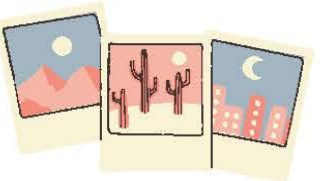

# WATER CONSERVATION

---

Do your Part to Protect our Resources!

Irrigation limited to **3 times**  
per week

Odd addresses = Mon/Wed/Fri

Even Addresses = Tue/Thu/Sat

Turn off water for outdoor  
irrigation **during or within 48 hours**  
after measurable rainfall

Use of **potable water** for irrigation of  
non-functional, ornamental turf  
prohibited at commercial, industrial,  
and institutional sites

Limit irrigation to no more than **15**  
**minutes** per station with no runoff

No lawn irrigation between  
**10 a.m. - 4 p.m.**

No washing of **hard surfaces**, such as  
sidewalks/driveways
