The following details the circus operation:

EXPECTED ATTENDANCE: 300 per performance (average)

LENGTH OF SHOW: Approximately two hours

DIAMETER OF TENT: Approximately 120 x 203 feet

SEATING CAPACITY OF TENT: 866

SQUARE FOOT OF ENTIRE CIRCUS AREA: 180 feet by 180 feet (approx.)

NUMBER OF PARKING SPACES USED: Approximately 150

DEPTH OF TENT STAKES: 3 FEET DIG ALERT IS CALLED PRIOR TO STAKING

NUMBER OF HOUSE TRAILERS: 8

NO GAMES OF CHANCE

The show travels with eight 40-foot RV's. All RVs are attached to the show generator. Around the perimeter of the operation are 6-foot by 4-foot free-standing barriers that are linked together. A source of water will be provided to the circus by the venue on which the circus conducts business. The circus has hoses to access the water source. There are no additional signs, other than what is painted on the side of trucks and the name of the show on top of the tent.

The main tent is round with a diameter of 131 feet. It is flame retardant and a certificate is available to you. The tent has four lighted exits, each are ten feet wide. There are fourteen fire extinguishers in the tent, located at exits on quarter poles and under bleachers, which are serviced and inspected on a regular basis.

The lighting outside of the tent will be existing parking lot lights. The only additional lighting we will provide will be inside the tent.

Circus Caballero carries its own porta-potties, one of which is Handicapped Accessible and these are serviced two times each week or more often if necessary. Waste is disposed of via a 40 yard dumpster which is owned by the circus and hauled to local dump area in each city.

The show travels with twelve 53-foot trailers

There are no free-standing signs around the circus. The only signs on the outside of the tents are either painted directly on the sides of the trucks or is the name of the circus in lights on the top of the tent. There are no lights that illuminate the truck signs. Pictures are attached.

As public safety is a major concern, Circus Caballero has six uniformed, unarmed, in-house security officers on-duty during show hours. (Typically no outside security is needed, nor hired.) They see to it that all city ordinances are consistently observed, as well as assisting with on-site parking and crowd control.

In order to accommodate physically challenged patrons, Circus Caballero has implemented the following in accordance with **TITLE 24 DISABLED ACCESS**:

1. A designated parking area at the closest point of access to the circus. This will be located as close as logistically feasible to the entrance of the circus.
2. A physically challenged drop-off zone at the nearest point possible to the entrance.
3. One handicapped restroom, equipped with handrails and ramps will be available at all times.

Circus Caballero arrives on site two days before the day of the first scheduled performance. Set-up begins early morning of that day. All inspections are scheduled for opening day around 4:00 P.M. At this time, the circus is set up enough for inspectors, while not yet open to the public, allowing circus personnel to make any needed adjustments as required. At conclusion of appearance, Circus Caballero patches all stake holes with cold patch.

If you have special concerns that need to be addressed, I would suggest coming out on one of the set-up days and speaking with circus owner Ruben Caballero. This can be easily arranged for you. Site will be restored to original condition upon its departure.

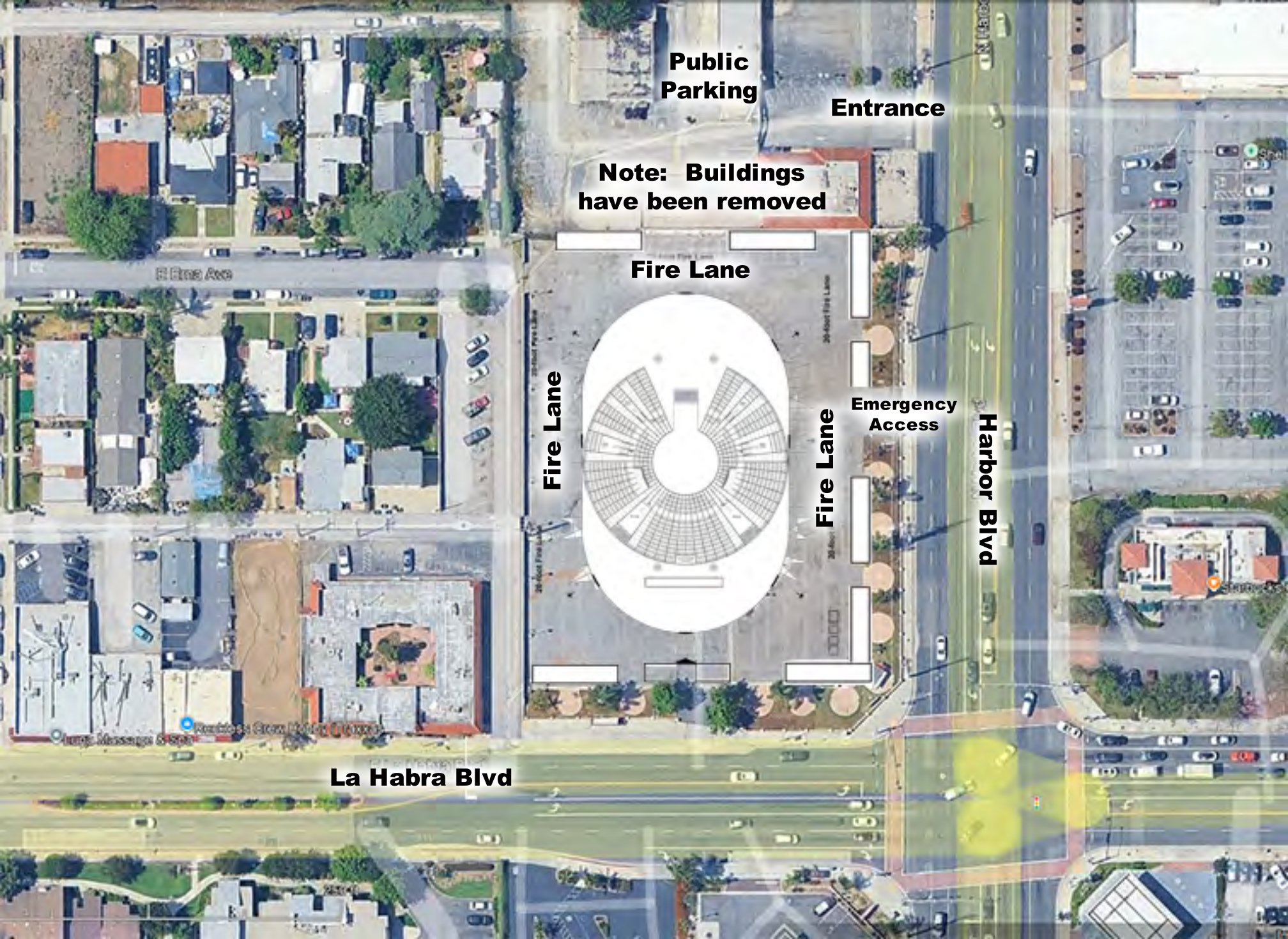

- 2022 CFC and 2021 NFPA 30 to be followed
