A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LITTLE ELM, TEXAS CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION HELD IN THE TOWN OF LITTLE ELM ON JUNE 23, 2012, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM, ONE (1) COUNCIL MEMBER FOR PLACE 3 FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM, ONE (1) COUNCIL MEMBER TO PLACE 4 FOR THE REMAINDER OF AN UNEXPIRED THREE (3) YEAR TERM, AND ONE (1) COUNCIL MEMBER TO PLACE 5 FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM; MAKING OTHER DECLARATIONS AND FINDING OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE SAID ELECTION SET FORTH HEREIN; FINDING THAT ALL MATTERS SET FORTH HEREIN ARE TRUE AND CORRECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there was heretofore ordered and called for the Town of Little Elm, Texas (the "Town") a Runoff Election to be held on June 23, 2012 for the purpose of electing a Mayor for a three (3) year term, one (1) Council Member for Place 3 for a three (3) year term, one (1) Council member for Place 4 for the remainder of an unexpired three (3) year term, and one (1) Council member to Place 5 for a three (3) year term each (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, the appropriate authority of the Town caused to be posted and published, in accordance with applicable laws, notices for the Election; and

WHEREAS, the Election was duly and legally held on June 23, 2012 in the Town and in conformity with the Town Charter and the election laws of the State, and the results of the Election, including early voting results, have been delivered by the presiding election judge in accordance with law and have been delivered to the Town Council as the canvassing authority in accordance with law; and
