

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CHIEF OF POLICE, THROUGH THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, TO ACCEPT THE 2026 NRA FOUNDATION STATE FUND GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO

WHEREAS, the City of Lorain Police Department has been awarded a 2026 NRA Foundation grant in the amount of \$5,126.00.

WHEREAS, The NRA Foundation First Grant Program is designed to support local law enforcement in their crucial role of maintaining public safety, the Grantee hereby agrees to adhere to any assurances, special conditions and limitations as are set forth within the NRA Foundation grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO;

SECTION I. That the Chief of Police, through the Mayor, is authorized to accept the award of, The 2026 NRA Foundation State Fund grant. Project Title: LPD Firearms Unit Safety & Targeting Upgrades.

SECTION II. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22, of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, the nature of the emergency immediate need to execute the grant funds to preserve the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Lorain, Ohio, as the immediate need to accept the award, shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, providing it receives the statutory requirements for passage, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
