Each Council Member will get tabulation sheets showing the total number of votes cast for each candidate and the total number of votes cast for each candidate by precinct.

Tray Payne received a majority of the votes for the position of Mayor, Christy Martinez received the majority of the votes for the position of City Council-District 1, and Jennifer Wilson received the majority of the votes for the position of City Council-District 5. Mark McBrayer, candidate for the City Council-District 3 position was unopposed; therefore he was the only one to receive votes in the District 3 category.
