Item Summary

A General Election was held on May 7, 2022, in the City of Lubbock, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and City Council Members for Districts 1, 3, and 5. The governing body is required to canvass the election results not earlier than the third day or later than the eleventh day after Election Day. Each Council Member will get tabulation sheets showing the total number of votes cast for each candidate and the total number of votes cast for each candidate by precinct.

Tray Payne received a majority of the votes for the position of Mayor, Christy Martinez received the majority of the votes for the position of City Council-District 1, and Jennifer Wilson received the majority of the votes for the position of City Council-District 5. Mark McBrayer, candidate for the City Council-District 3 position was unopposed; therefore he was the only one to receive votes in the District 3 category.
