Item Summary

A Special Election was held on June 27, 2026, in the City of Lubbock, for the purpose of electing a City Council Member for District 4 to fill an unexpired term. The governing body is required to canvass the election results not earlier than the third day or later than the eleventh day after Election Day. Each Council Member will receive tabulation sheets showing the total number of votes cast for each candidate and the total number of votes cast for each candidate by precinct.

If no candidate for a particular office receives more than 50 percent of the vote, then a runoff election must be ordered for that office. No candidate received a majority of the votes for the position of City Council-District 4. The runoff election will be held on August 1, 2026.

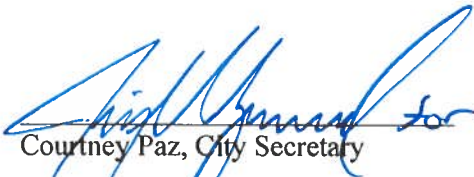
