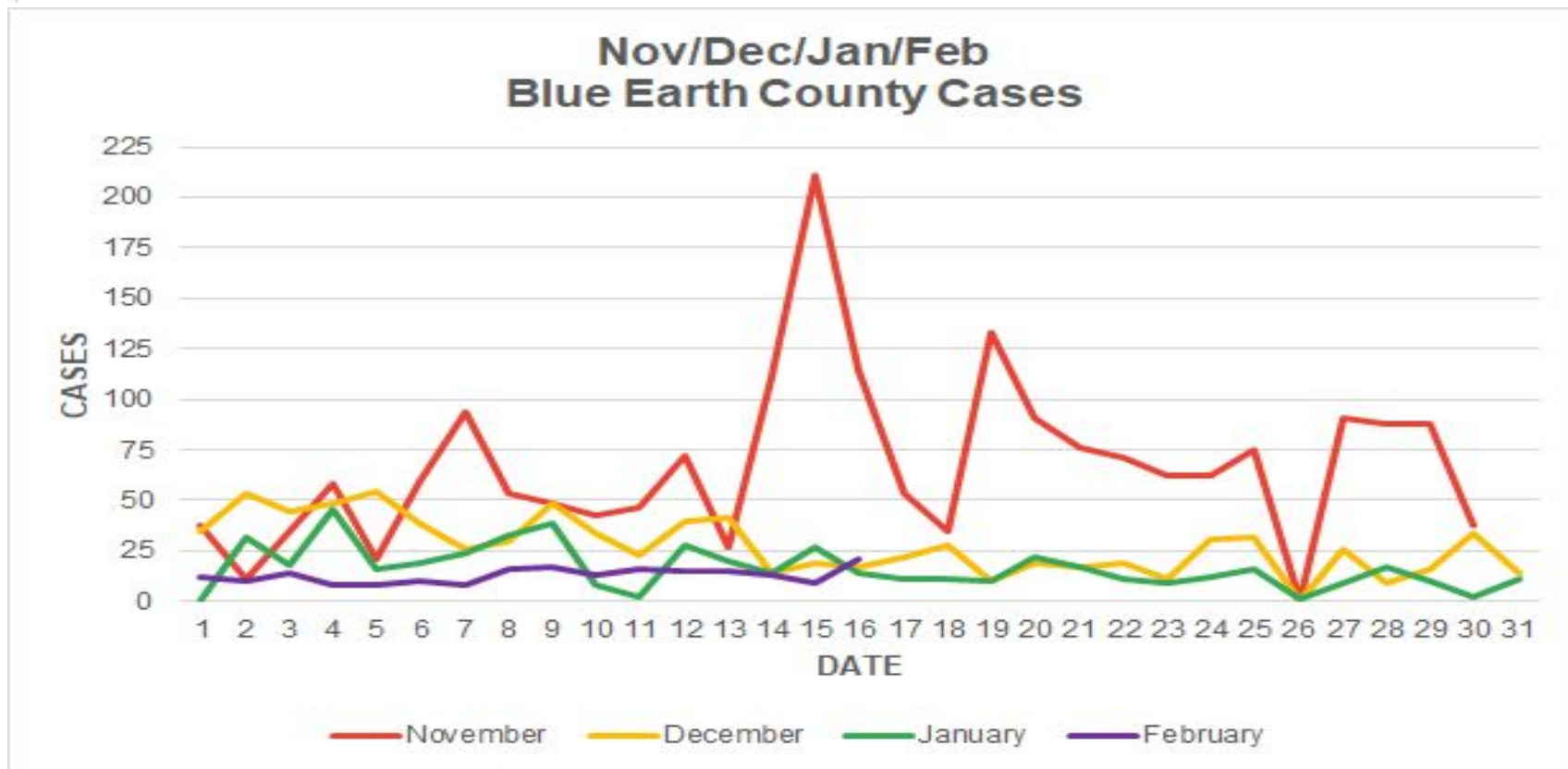

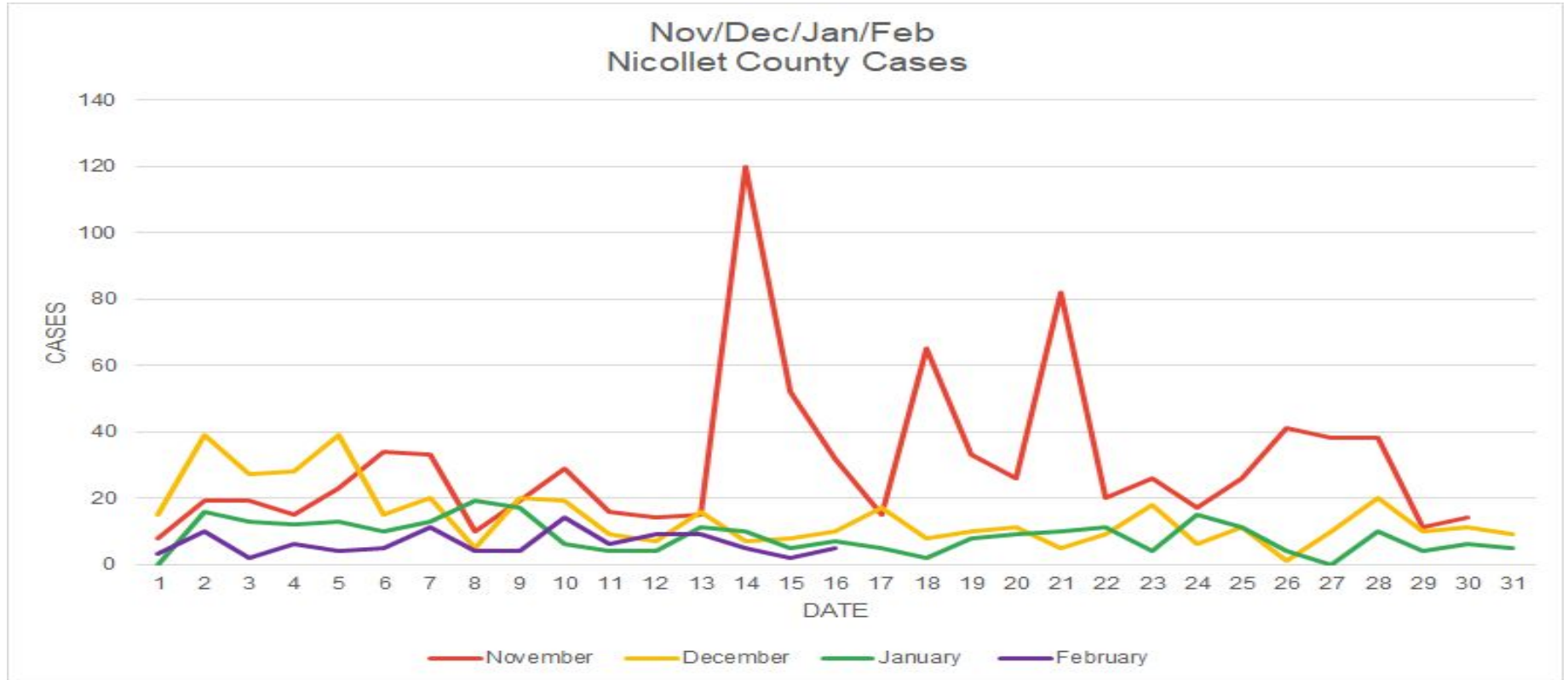


Blue Earth County COVID-19 Data
