

2023 Calendar Adjustment

Due to weather-related cancellations this school year, Mankato Area Public Schools (MAPS) will make a change to the current school calendar to meet the MN Statute for classroom instruction. MAPS staff have worked together to identify days that will change from non-student contact days to regular student days. For each additional cancellation of a school day, we will need to add a K-12 student day to the calendar. Please see the attached school calendar which has been updated to reflect these changes.

2023 Calendar for March 10	
K-5	Students will ATTEND school on March 10 and will be released at 12:30 (12:50 for Bridges). This day will run like an Early Release day.
6-8	Students DO NOT attend school on March 10 due to Parent-Teacher conferences.
9-12	Students ATTEND school as scheduled on March 10.

To add minutes/hours to meet state requirements, these changes will also occur:

- Beginning March 6, Central High School will be adding 10 minutes to the beginning of their school day for the rest of the school year. Central will begin at 8:20.
- Prairie Winds and Dakota Meadows will add five minutes to the end of each school day from Monday, March 13, 2023, through Monday, March 20, 2023. Students will be dismissed at 3:25 pm instead of 3:20 pm. This action is needed because we have fallen 30 minutes short of instructional time at the middle school level required by state statute.

Days in June beginning with June 8	Students attend school * No changes to graduation date
