



# First Reading of Policies

## Policy 427 Performance Evaluation - Licensed Staff

- Revises the number of formal observations for teachers who have continuing contract status, a.k.a. tenure.

## Policy 538 MSHSL Cooperative Sponsorships

- Removes language regarding non-charter online schools to align policy with MSHSL bylaws and state statute.



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## Policy 601 School District Curriculum and Instruction Goals

- Revises language to align with recent statutory changes regarding the World's Best Workforce Plan and new READ Act.

## Policy 602 Organization of School Calendar and School Day

- Adds new language regarding e-learning days to align with state statute.



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## Policy 603 Curriculum Development

- Adds new language regarding revised requirements for the District Advisory Committee and site teams.

## Policy 604 Instructional Curriculum

- Revises policy language to address required subjects and areas of academic standards for state accountability.



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## Policy 631 Literacy and the READ Act (New Policy)

- New policy that provides guidance for implementing the new READ Act legislation.

## Policy 632 Credit for Learning

- Revises policy to reflect recent statutory changes regarding online learning, post-secondary enrollment credit, and new criteria for students to earn credit for employment with health care providers.



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## Policy 635 Online Instruction

- Revises policy to reflect new Online Instruction Act that was recently pass into law and replaced the Online Learning Option Act.

## Policy 708 Transportation of Nonpublic School Students

- Adds language to align with new statutory provisions that allow for a written plan for students who attend nonpublic schools.



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## Policy 709 Student Transportation Safety Policy

- Revises language to include new required active transportation safety training, and aligns definition of Type III vehicles with federal regulations.

## Policy 809 Crisis Management Policy

- Adds language for new statutory requirements associated with active shooter drills, and aligns procedures language with district's revised Standard Response Protocol and crisis response plan.
