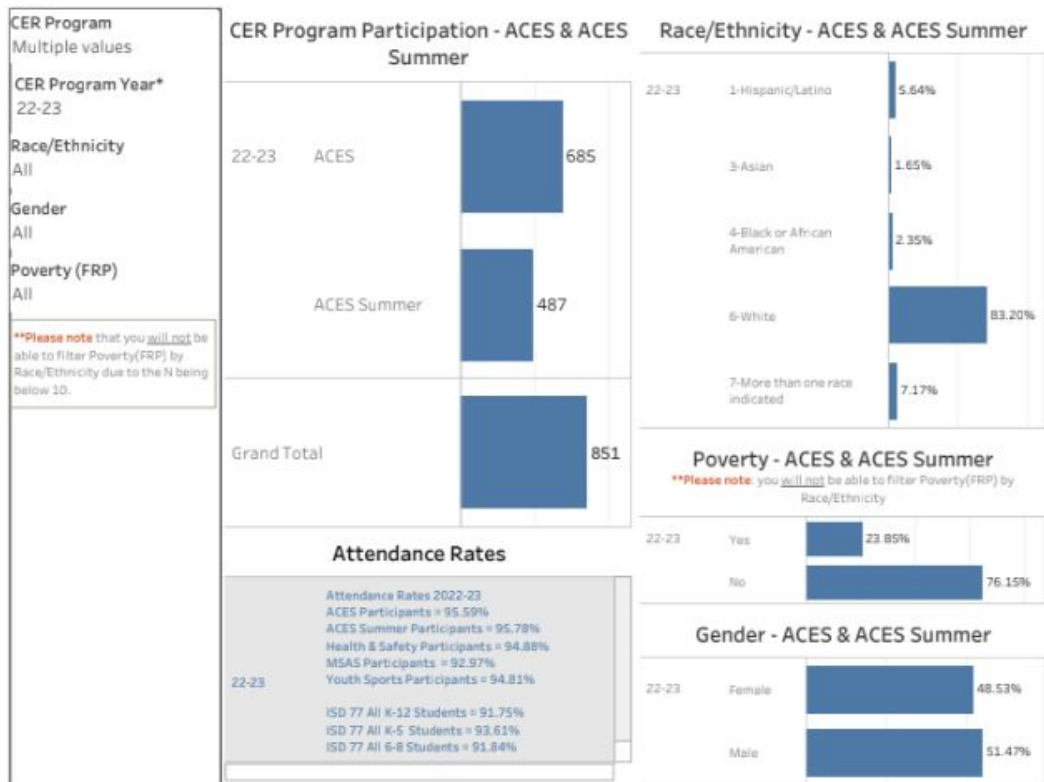

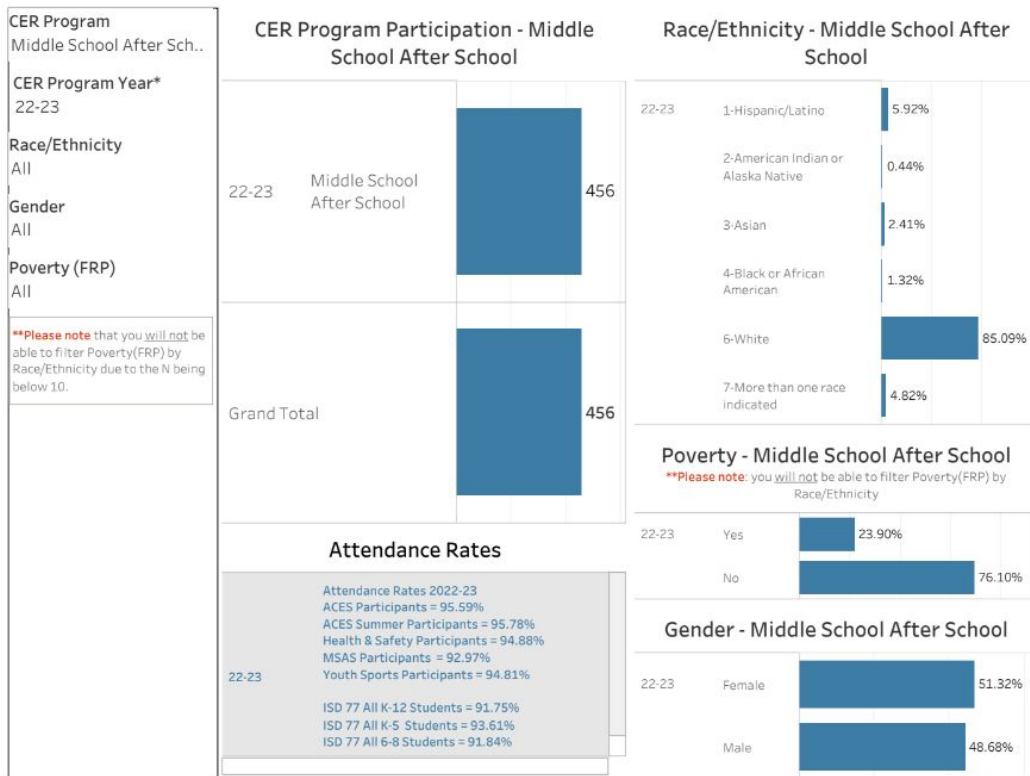


22-23 Student Demographics



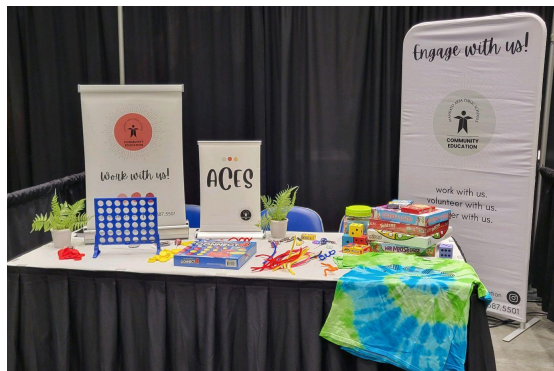

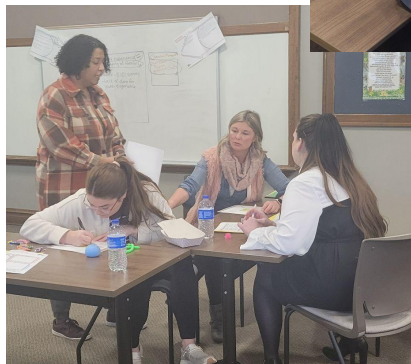
