522 Title IX Sex Nondiscrimination Policy, Grievance Procedure and Process

First Reading of Policies

- Clarifies procedures that when students are interviewed at school as a part of maltreatment investigations, the interview may take place outside the presence of the alleged offender.
- Revises the policy to align with the 2020 Title IX rules. The Office for Civil Rights issued guidance on February 4, 2025 to revert back to following the 2020 rules instead of 2024 rules based on a ruling by a Federal judge in January.



701 Establishment and Adoption of School District Budget

727 Uniform Grant Guidance Policy Regarding Federal Revenue Sources

- Adds clarifying statement that when projected expenditures exceed projected revenues the school board may consider the use of an available fund balance, should one exist.
- Increases equipment threshold hold from \$5,000 to \$10,000
- Revises procurement threshold to be \$175,000 to align with sealed bid requirements
- Adds cybersecurity section requiring school district to take reasonable measures to protect sensitive data and personally identifiable information.
