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Goal #1

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Goal #2

The percentage of students in each student group who meet or exceed on the 3rd grade Reading MCA will increase from 2025–2029 by 3% each year to close the achievement gap.

Strategies:

Coaching around literacy best practice and the Science of Reading

Access to Literature and Family Resources to provide support inside and outside the school day

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Goal #3

The percentage of students in each student group in Grade 8 who demonstrate interest in teacher career pathway activities will increase by 2% each year.

Strategies:

Expand middle school education pathways

Access to Project Success to provide rich experiences



Goal #4

The percentage of students of color and FRPL who participate in a career pathway partnership will increase by 2% each year.

Strategies:

Access to more career pathways through job shadowing, internships, career forums, project based learning, and industry tours.
