#### JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

THIS JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT, and amendments and supplements thereto, (hereinafter "contract") is between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities, on behalf of Minnesota State University, Mankato, 238 Wigley Administration Center, Mankato, MN 56001 (hereinafter "UNIVERSITY"), which is empowered to enter into joint powers agreements pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 471.59, Subd. 10, and the City of Mankato, 10 Civic Center Plaza, P.O. Box 3368, Mankato, MN 56002-3368 (hereinafter "CITY"), which is empowered to enter into joint powers agreements pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 471.59, Subd. 10;

WHEREAS, CITY represents that it is duly qualified and willing to perform the services set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual undertakings and agreements hereinafter set forth, the CITY and UNIVERSITY agree as follows:

1. This Agreement shall be contingent upon approval of the grant from the Minnesota Department of Transportation for which CITY has applied.
2. **Definitions:** The terms defined in this section shall, for purposes of the Agreement, have the meanings herein specified unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
  - a. "Revenues" shall mean sums of money collected by the CITY from:
    - i. The fare boxes on the buses when used to provide the Campus Circulator, Route 1A North, Route 1A South, Route 1B North, Route 1B South, Route 8 (Campus Circulator), Route 9 (Morning Express), Route 12 (Nighttime Express) and Nighttime Stomper Express (Route 33) bus service to the UNIVERSITY.
    - ii. The sale of interior and exterior bus advertising on the two (2) buses used to provide all day service on the Campus Express and the Campus Circulator bus routes.
  - b. "Equipment" shall mean all buses used to provide this contractual service along with tires, seats, signs, and bike racks affixed to buses.
  - c. "Bus Service" shall mean transporting the general public and trained service animals on buses within the designated service area.

- d. “Operating Hour” shall mean the amount of time elapsing between the time the bus arrives at its initial starting point on the route and the time it departs for the bus garage from its ending point on the route; rounded to the nearest one half (1/2) hour.
  - e. “Campus Express” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 6:00 PM and ending at 10:00 PM or any fraction thereof, Monday through Thursday and Friday, commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 6:00 PM, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - f. “Route 1A North” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 6:00 PM, Monday through Thursday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - g. “Route 1A South” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 6:00 PM, Monday through Thursday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - h. “Route 1B North” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - i. “Route 1B South” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 6:00 PM, Monday through Thursday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - j. “Route 8 Campus Circulator” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - k. “Route 9 Morning Express” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 7:00 AM and ending at 10:00 AM, Monday through Friday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - l. “Route 12 Nighttime Express” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 6:00 PM and ending at 10:00 PM or any fraction thereof, Monday through Thursday, during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
  - m. “Route 33 Nighttime Stomper Express” shall mean the hours of operation commencing at 6:00 PM and ending at 11:00 PM or any fraction thereof, Monday through Saturday, beginning the Monday prior to the start of the UNIVERSITY academic school year, August 15, 2022, and continuing through the end of the UNIVERSITY academic school year, May 5, 2023 (last day of classes).
3. **Services:** The CITY shall provide bus service between the UNIVERSITY campus and selected adjacent neighborhoods as scheduled in accordance with Exhibit 4. In addition, the CITY shall offer a reduced fare within the U-Zone (see attached Exhibit 4). Paragraphs 2.a. and 5.b. do not apply to revenues collected within the U-Zone by routes other than the “Campus Express” or “Route 8 Campus Circulator.”
- a. User friendly “Live Bus Tracking” has been developed through a collaborative effort of the Information Technology Departments of the CITY and UNIVERSITY. This mobile application allows the bus riders the opportunity to use electronic devices, including “smart phones”, to find out the location of a bus on any route. Within the bus location system, consistent within a timeframe mutually agreed to by the CITY and University, provision is in process to incorporate the use of the UNIVERSITY small on-campus Daytime Maverick Shuttle and Nighttime Red Eye Shuttles.
4. **Schedule/Routes:** The bus service provided by the CITY shall be rendered at such times and dates and along such routes as set forth in the schedules attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit 4. The UNIVERSITY may, after consultation with the CITY and approval from MnDOT Office of Transit and Active Transportation (Minnesota Department of Transportation), affect reductions in the schedule as set forth in Exhibit 4 upon a thirty (30) day prior written notice to the CITY. ***See Exhibit 4.***

All route maps affecting the Route 1A North, Route 1A South, Route 1B North, Route 1B South, Route 8 Campus Circulator, Route 9 Morning Express, Route 12 Nighttime Express, Campus Express and the Route 33 Nighttime Stomper Express will be printed by the UNIVERSITY’S Printing and Photocopying Services

Department. The cost of this printing shall be at the expense of the UNIVERSITY. Prior to the beginning of the academic year, the UNIVERSITY may request CITY bus service for episodic or extended service of the existing daily schedule. The CITY, if they can provide such service, may provide the following service:

February 20, 2023, (President’s Day) Monday: 8:15 AM - 10:00 AM

Fall Semester Commencement: Three (3) buses.

Saturday, December 10, 2022: 8:00 AM - 3:00 PM;

*(The two Saturday ceremonies are scheduled at 9:00 AM and 12 PM (Noon))*

All episodic service for the 2022-2023 UNIVERSITY academic school year must be identified in this Agreement.

Episodic service requested after this Agreement has been executed shall not be provided.

## 5. **Per Hour Rates, Bus Pass Prices and Other Finance Related Considerations:**

*See Exhibit 2: Stomper Express Cost Breakout Estimate*

- a. The UNIVERSITY shall pay the CITY for services provided based on a per hour rate of One Hundred Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$105.00). Services shall include the Campus Express, Route 1A North, Route 1A South, Route 1B North, Route 1B South, Route 8 Campus Circulator, Route 9 Morning Express, Route 12 Nighttime Express, Route 33 Nighttime Stomper Express, and episodic service.

- b. The Thursday, Friday and Saturday Route 33 Nighttime Stomper Express which operates during the UNIVERSITY academic school year, is funded through a shared arrangement between the CITY and the UNIVERSITY. The Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday Route 33 Nighttime Stomper Express which operates during the academic school year is funded by the UNIVERSITY. Hours and cost responsibilities are displayed as follows:

The UNIVERSITY shall pay no more than **Five Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand One Hundred Forty-Six and 00/100 dollars (\$535,146.00)** for the 2022-2023 academic school year, including the service beginning the week of August 15, 2022. If hours are adjusted down due to cancellation of scheduled service during the semester (i.e. weather), a corresponding reduction in total cost will be reflected in the semester invoice.

- c. The expense for providing thirty-five (35) hours of Monday through Sunday Stomper Express service the week prior to the start of the UNIVERSITY academic school year shall be borne by the UNIVERSITY. These hours of service shall be in addition to the service provided during the UNIVERSITY academic school year.
- d. The standard bus fare of One and 50/100 Dollars (\$1.50) will be waived for all UNIVERSITY students and employees riding the Nighttime Stomper Express by showing the driver a valid UNIVERSITY MavCard. The prevailing bus fare will apply to all other persons.
- e. The UNIVERSITY will pay the CITY Seven Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,500.00) at the end of Fall Semester 2022 and Seven Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$7,500.00) at the end of Spring Semester 2023 in recognition of the lost cash fare and bus pass sales that will occur because of all UNIVERSITY students, faculty and staff being able to board any fixed route CITY bus using their MavCard. The program allowing students, faculty and staff to board CITY buses using their MavCard is strictly limited to those students, faculty and staff that are currently enrolled at/employed by the UNIVERSITY. This program shall not be extended to other public or private organization or person without prior consent from the CITY.
- f. On Demand services are not included and exempt from MavCARD "Free Ride" Provisions
6. **Nondiscrimination:** In connection with the performance of this Agreement, both the CITY and the UNIVERSITY shall not discriminate against any person because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, creed, age, marital status, or status with regard to public assistance or physical disability or any other group or class against which discrimination is prohibited by State or Federal Law, including Title IX of the Education Amendment of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Section 402 of the Vietnam Era Veterans Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974.
- Both parties agree to execute any documents and agreements which may be required of either party by the State of Minnesota or the United States Government or its agencies to demonstrate compliance with any laws or regulations requiring nondiscrimination or affirmative action in the operation of this agreement.
7. **Authority of CITY:** The CITY enters into this Agreement by authorization of its CITY Council by resolution adopted, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit B (***MSU Contract Exhibit 5***).
8. **Authority of UNIVERSITY:** The UNIVERSITY enters into this Agreement by authorization of Minnesota Statute 136F, Subdivision 3.
9. **Termination by UNIVERSITY:** The UNIVERSITY may terminate or modify the service to be provided hereunder upon thirty (30) days' written notice to the CITY, but such termination shall not relieve the UNIVERSITY from its obligations to pay costs incurred on a prorated basis up to date of termination.
10. **Term of Contract/Dates and Hours of Service:** This Agreement shall be for a term commencing on Monday, August 15, 2022, and terminate on Saturday, May 6, 2023. The dates of operation/hours of service

and dates without service shall be described in Exhibit 3. ***See Exhibit 3: Bus Routes, Times, and Dates (2 pages)***

11. **Termination by CITY:** The CITY may at any time terminate this Agreement upon a thirty (30) days' written notice to the UNIVERSITY only if it is unable to procure the necessary equipment and/or personnel to perform the day-to-day operational requirements of this contract. The CITY shall, however, use its best efforts to procure personnel and equipment.
12. **Modification:** The UNIVERSITY and the CITY agree that no modification of this Agreement, except as stipulated in Paragraph 4 shall be binding on them or either of them unless such modification is offered in writing and duly accepted in writing by both parties.
13. **Integration:** This document is fully integrated, embodying the entire agreement between the parties.
14. **Non-Waiver of Rights:** The failure of either party to insist upon strict performance of any of the terms, covenants or conditions herein shall not be deemed a waiver of any subsequent breach or default.
15. **Notice:** Any notice required to be given in this Agreement by either the CITY or UNIVERSITY shall be sufficient if provided via email or mailed by United States mail or actual personal service of the notice. Notice to the CITY shall be emailed to Shawn Schloesser at [sschloesser@mankatomn.gov](mailto:sschloesser@mankatomn.gov) or delivered to Mankato Transit, 10 Civic Center Plaza, P.O. Box 3368, Mankato, MN 56002-3368. Notice to the UNIVERSITY shall be emailed to Richard Straka at [richard.straka@mnsu.edu](mailto:richard.straka@mnsu.edu) or delivered to the Vice President for Finance and Administration, 238 Wigley Administration Center, Minnesota State University, Mankato, Mankato, MN 56001.
16. **Liability:** The parties agree that each will be liable for any loss or damage to property or for personal injury or death which may be attributed to each party's negligent acts as determined by a court of law. The UNIVERSITY'S liability is limited by Minnesota Statute 3.736 and other applicable law.
17. **Liability Insurance:** In connection with the operation of this Agreement, the CITY shall maintain liability insurance coverage, including automobile insurance, in an amount equal to the maximum liability imposed by Minnesota Statutes Section 466.04, (***see Exhibit 7***), as it may be amended from time to time. As to insurance policies procured and maintained by the CITY in compliance with this section of the Agreement, the CITY shall submit to the UNIVERSITY'S Vice President for Finance & Administration Office, a certified copy of the insurance policy prior to the effective date of the Agreement.

Any insurance policy procured by the CITY pursuant to this clause shall name the UNIVERSITY as an additional named insured on such insurance policy and provide that the UNIVERSITY shall be given ten (10) days' written notice before cancellation or reduction by carrier of such coverage. The CITY agrees that it will give the UNIVERSITY thirty (30) days' notice in writing of any request it may make for cancellation or reduction of such coverage.
18. **Control of Operations:** The CITY shall retain complete control over the operation of buses used in providing the service. This control shall include limiting the number of passengers on any given bus, the decision not to provide the service at any given time due to the condition of the equipment, streets or weather, limiting the number of stops and selection of personnel to operate buses. The CITY shall use its best efforts to provide the service described in this Agreement, but in the case of mechanical failure of a bus, shall not be obligated to obtain additional equipment or discontinue other services to provide the service to the UNIVERSITY. Changes in performance however, including limiting the number of stops or other changes in scheduling shall be made only after consultation with the UNIVERSITY and a written or emailed notice is given.
19. **State Audits:** The books, records, documents and accounting procedures and practices of the CITY relevant to this Agreement shall be subject to examination by the UNIVERSITY and the legislative auditor and/or state auditor as appropriate.

20. **Advertising:** Promotional efforts encouraging ridership is a shared responsibility between the CITY and the UNIVERSITY. The printing of bus schedules and updates shall be a UNIVERSITY responsibility as well as the printing of large posters for on-campus bus shelters. The CITY will advertise the service provided hereunder in appropriate media, including but not limited to, the Minnesota State UNIVERSITY, Mankato Campus Reporter Newspaper. The CITY shall distribute such schedules to affected apartment complexes. Reporter display ads are the responsibility of the CITY which will publish display ads at the beginning of each semester. Promotional novelties (e.g., key chains, lanyards, backpacks, etc.) are financial undertaking of UNIVERSITY (due to grant restrictions for CITY) but there will be a shared responsibility of distribution between CITY and UNIVERSITY.
21. **Consideration and Terms of Payment:** In consideration of services performed by the CITY under this Agreement, the UNIVERSITY agrees to pay the CITY the estimated amounts as outlined on the budget and identified as Exhibit C, which is hereby attached hereto and made a part of this Agreement.
- Should fare box revenues (Paragraph 5.d.) and advertising revenues (Paragraph 25) exceed the estimated amount as shown in Exhibit 6, then the net cost to the UNIVERSITY shall be reduced by the excess amount of such revenues. Conversely, should fare box recovery or advertising revenue not meet the projected estimates, the net cost to the UNIVERSITY shall be increased by the amount of the shortfall. The UNIVERSITY agrees to make two payments based upon the following schedule upon receipt of invoice: ***See Exhibit 6: UNIVERSITY Agrees to Pay the CITY.***
22. **Cancellations:** In the event of cancellation, the UNIVERSITY shall be liable for the payments due in Paragraph 21, less rebates received by the CITY, for cancellation of costs to the CITY regardless of whether the UNIVERSITY cancels or modified the service provided hereunder, as determined on a pro rata basis of termination, only for services performed.
23. **Warranty of Financial Responsibilities:** The UNIVERSITY warrants to the CITY that it is financially responsible and able to perform all the monetary requirements of this Agreement. If requested, the UNIVERSITY shall provide documentary evidence to the CITY demonstrating the existence and commitment of funds sufficient to perform its commitments. Such documentary evidence shall be supplied to the CITY within twenty (20) days of its request.
24. **Suspension of CITY's Obligations:** The obligations of the CITY hereunder shall be suspended to the extent that it is hindered or prevented from complying herewith because of labor disturbances, including strikes and lockouts, Acts of God, fires, storms, accidents governmental regulations or interferences of any cause whatsoever beyond the control of the CITY.
- Force Majeure – The time within which any of the Parties hereto shall be required to perform any act or acts under this contract, except for payment of monies, shall be extended to the extent that the performance of such act or acts shall be delayed by acts of God, fire, windstorm, flood, explosion, collapse of structures, riot, war, labor, and/or legal disputes, delays or restrictions by government bodies, inability to obtain or use necessary materials, or any cause beyond the reasonable control of such Party (any such delay being called “unavoidable delay” in this contract), provided however that the Party entitled to such extension hereunder shall give prompt notice to the other Party of the occurrence causing such delay.
25. **Advertising Revenues:** Revenues from advertising placed in/on the two regularly scheduled all day Campus Express or Campus Circulator buses shall be credited to the UNIVERSITY.
26. **Data Practices Act –** Information supplied by UNIVERSITY to CITY is subject to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 13 (the “Act”). Such information shall become public unless it falls into one of the exceptions of the Act. UNIVERSITY shall notify CITY in writing of any data UNIVERSITY believes is classified as non-public..
27. **No Assignment –** This contract may not be assigned by either party without the written consent of the other party.

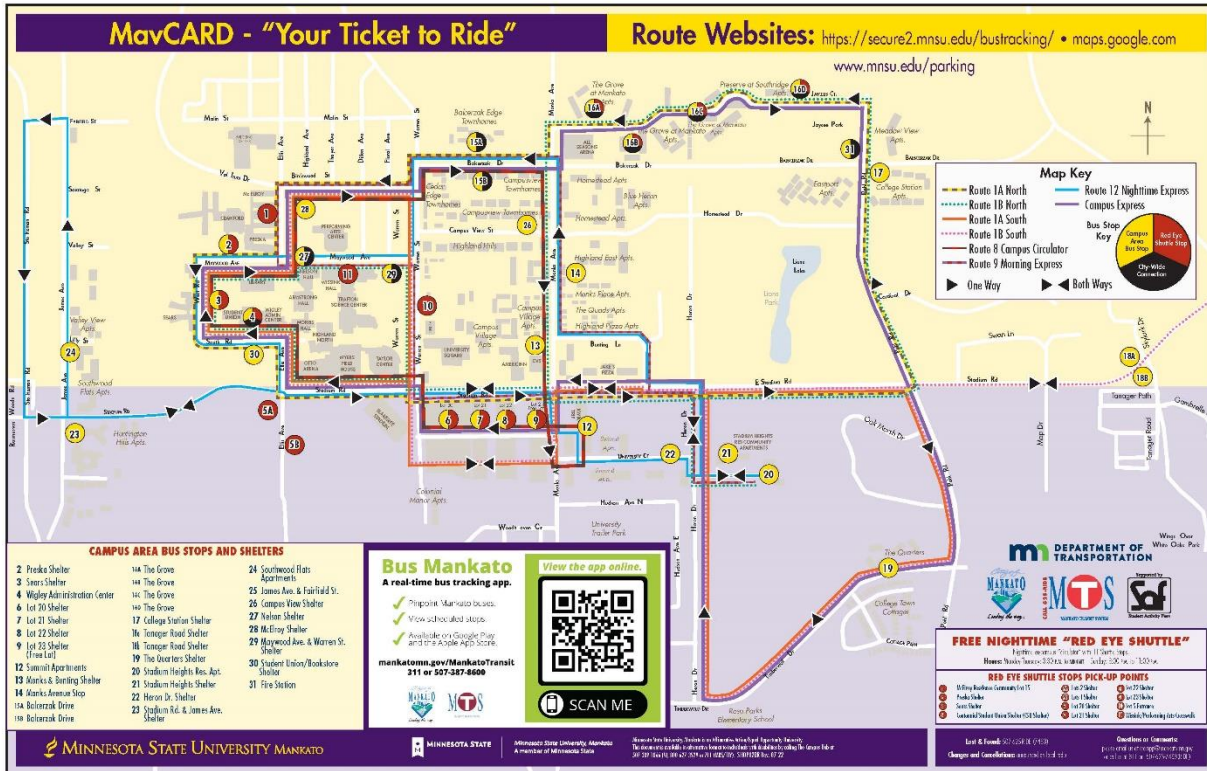

## EXHIBIT 7

2021 Minnesota Statutes

### **466.04 MAXIMUM LIABILITY.**

#### **Subdivision 1. Limits; punitive damages.**

(a) Liability of any municipality on any claim within the scope of sections 466.01 to 466.15 shall not exceed:

(1) \$300,000 when the claim is one for death by wrongful act or omission and \$300,000 to any claimant in any other case, for claims arising before January 1, 2008;

(2) \$400,000 when the claim is one for death by wrongful act or omission and \$400,000 to any claimant in any other case, for claims arising on or after January 1, 2008, and before July 1, 2009;

(3) \$500,000 when the claim is one for death by wrongful act or omission and \$500,000 to any claimant in any other case, for claims arising on or after July 1, 2009;

(4) \$750,000 for any number of claims arising out of a single occurrence, for claims arising on or after January 1, 1998, and before January 1, 2000;

(5) \$1,000,000 for any number of claims arising out of a single occurrence, for claims arising on or after January 1, 2000, and before January 1, 2008;

(6) \$1,200,000 for any number of claims arising out of a single occurrence, for claims arising on or after January 1, 2008, and before July 1, 2009;

(7) \$1,500,000 for any number of claims arising out of a single occurrence, for claims arising on or after July 1, 2009;

(8) twice the limits provided in clauses (1) to (7) when the claim arises out of the release or threatened release of a hazardous substance, whether the claim is brought under sections 115B.01 to 115B.15 or under any other law; or

(9) \$1,000,000 for any number of claims arising out of a single occurrence, if the claim involves a nonprofit organization engaged in or administering outdoor recreational activities funded in whole or in part by a municipality or operating under the authorization of a permit issued by a municipality.

(b) No award for damages on any such claim shall include punitive damages.

#### **Subd. 1a. Officers and employees.**

The liability of an officer or an employee of any municipality for a tort arising out of an alleged act or omission occurring in the performance of duty shall not exceed the limits set forth in subdivision 1, unless the officer or employee provides professional services and also is employed in the profession for compensation by a person or persons other than the municipality.

#### **Subd. 1b. Total claim.**

The total liability of the municipality on a claim against it and against its officers or employees arising out of a single occurrence shall not exceed the limits set forth in subdivision 1.

#### **Subd. 2. Inclusions.**

The limitation imposed by this section on individual claimants includes damages claimed for loss of services or loss of support arising out of the same tort.

#### **Subd. 3. Disposition of multiple claims.**

Where the amount awarded to or settled upon multiple claimants exceeds the applicable limit under subdivision 1, paragraph (a), clauses (4) to (9), any party may apply to any district court to apportion to each claimant a proper share of the total amount limited by subdivision 1. The share apportioned each claimant shall be in the proportion that the ratio of the award or settlement made to each bears to the aggregate awards and settlements for all claims arising out of the occurrence.
