

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH CENTRAL MINNESOTA
COMPUTER CONSORTIUM**

WHEREAS, the parties hereby establish the South Central MN Computer Consortium which shall be governed by the Joint Powers Board pursuant to Minnesota Statute 471.59; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the agreement is to provide for the joint exercise of the parties' powers requirement coordination to plan for the needs of the South Central MN Computer Consortium. The joint exercise of the parties powers pursuant to this agreement is intended to supplement and complement but not supplant the parties' joint and individual powers of planning and coordination, costs incurred to plan, implement and maintain a Records Management System (RMS), Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, Jail Management System (JMS), and Mobile Computer System (MCS); and

WHEREAS, without a signed Joint Powers Agreement, the Mankato Department of Public Safety would not be able to continue participation in this endeavor

WHEREAS, this agreement shall be in effect until May 13, 2029.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Mankato that the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with South Central Minnesota Computer Consortium for law enforcement records management and computer aided dispatch services.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and without further publication.
