

Resolution Authorizing Application for MNDNR Flood Hazard Mitigation Grant

WHEREAS, since 1987, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (MNDNR) Flood Hazard Mitigation (FHM) Grant Assistance Program has awarded over \$590 million in cost share funding to local governmental units around the state; and

WHEREAS, the City experienced significant flooding and damage to the Highland Park Ravine as part of the 2024 flooding; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the slop stabilization of the Highland Park Ravine is \$650,000; and

WHEREAS, the slope stabilization of the Highland Park Ravine is a priority for the City and qualifies as a project in accordance with the MN DNR Flood Hazard Mitigation Grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Mankato supports the grant application and authorizes the City Manager to submit the application for the MN DNR Flood Hazard Mitigation Grant.

This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
