

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING AN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY COMMUNITY-WIDE ASSESSMENT GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato recognizes the many benefits of brownfield redevelopment, including, but not limited to a cleaner environment, the reduction of possible threats to human health, the revitalization of established neighborhoods, and the utilization of existing infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato desires to encourage brownfield redevelopment through the completion of environmental assessments on brownfield property, especially within targeted redevelopment areas; and,

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency provides brownfield assessment grants in order to inventory, characterize, assess, and conduct planning and community involvement related to brownfields sites.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Mankato approves submission of a brownfield community-wide assessment grant application and the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit the application materials to the Environmental Protection Agency for funding of this grant on behalf of the City of Mankato.
