

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF
HEALTH PROJECT PRIORITY LIST AND THE MINNESOTA PUBLIC FACILITIES AUTHORITY
INTENDED USE PLAN FOR LEAD SERVICE LINE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato has completed the required Lead Service Line inventory update and submitted it to the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) for 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato has identified known lead and galvanized water services within the city system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato has previously applied to the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority (MPFA) for a loan and/or grant from the Drinking Water Revolving Fund for a lead service line replacement project in 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato estimates the MPFA-Financed amount to be \$1,000,000 or the as-bid cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato estimates replacement of the known lead and galvanized water services to be more than \$9 million; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mankato has been notified that additional grant funding may be available to the City of Mankato to complete a 2027 Lead Water Service Line Replacement Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MANKATO, MINNESOTA:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application to the MDH Project Priority List (PPL) due on Friday March 13, 2026, and the MPFA Intended Use Plan (IUP) due on Friday, June 5, 2026.
