NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement (AGE) Division has evidence that you obtained alcoholic beverages from another alcoholic beverage licensed retail account for resale at your location in violation of Minnesota Statute Chapter 340A.415 and Minnesota Rules Chapter 7515.0520.

Under the authority granted to the Department of Public Safety, Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement, the Division may impose civil penalties in the form of fines, license suspension, or license revocation for any violation of statute, rule, or ordinance pertaining to alcoholic beverages. Pursuant to this authority, you are hereby notified that a civil fine of **\$500.00** is being imposed for violation of Minnesota law as provided under Minnesota Statute 340A.415.

The fine is due within **20 days** of the date of this notice unless we are contacted within this period to contest the matter. If we have not received either (1) the \$500.00 payment, or (2) a written request to contest this enforcement action by **January 5, 2026**, your liquor license(s) will be suspended for a period of three days, beginning at **8:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 8, 2026**, and ending at **8:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 11, 2026**.

You are also advised that you have the right to request a hearing before an administrative law judge. Any such request must be submitted in writing to the undersigned within twenty days of the date of this Notice. If a hearing is requested, the Division will initiate a contested case proceeding pursuant to the Minnesota Administrative Procedures Act.

If you do not wish to contest this agency action, please submit a copy of this letter along with a check payable to **Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement** in the amount of **\$500.00**.
