SUMMARY MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER ROLL CALL

Facilitator Andrea De La Cruz called the meeting to order at 3:06 PM

ROLL CALL

Ms. De La Cruz called the roll. Committee Member, Parks and Recreation Director, Jim Conroy was absent. Jason Angell was not in attendance for the roll call, he arrived at 3:14 PM. All other Committee Members were present, constituting a quorum.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Ms. De La Cruz asked for a motion to approve the agenda.

Committee Member Burruel moved to approve the agenda as presented. Committee Member Hathaway seconded the motion. Motion passed, 5-0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM July 8, 2025

Ms. De La Cruz asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the July 8, 2025, meeting.

Committee Member Hathaway moved to approve the minutes as presented. Committee Member Burruel seconded the motion. Motion passed, 5-0.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Ms. De La Cruz announced and welcomed Jackie Craig as a new member of the Public Art Review Committee.

GENERAL ORDER OF BUSINESS

A.

Daniel Bradshaw from The Planning Center, and two representatives from Cemrock presented conceptual drawings of several design ideas for the rattlesnake themed art installation planned for Twin Peaks – Rattlesnake Pass site.

The committee reviewed the different design concepts, asked questions, and discussed preferences. By consensus, the group favored the color palette and realistic look of the snake of **Concept A**, particularly the realism of the rattle snake and rock on which the rattlesnake is positioned. However, members preferred the pose and scale of the rattlesnake depicted in **Concept B**.

The committees also discussed the possibility of putting up an educational sign explaining the reason the statue is a rattlesnake and educating the public about rattlesnakes.

It was agreed that all concepts would be presented to the Town Council, with the committee's preference noted for consideration. The final decision on the design will ultimately rest with the Council.

Committee Member Angell moved to recommend the approval of a combination of Concept A and Concept B with the agreed upon changes (specifically, the rattlesnake and boulder elements from Concept A combined with the pose from Concept B). Ms. Hathaway Seconded the motion. Motion passed, 6-0.

B. Discussion and feedback on potential locations for public art project at El Rio Preserve.

Committee members De La Cruz and Burruel reported that most of the property along the El Rio Preserve is owned by Pima County, so the Town will need the County's approval before moving forward with an art installation at this site. **Ms. De La Cruz** and **Mr. Burruel** identified a couple of possible locations should permission be granted and, after reviewing both on the map, the committee agreed on the piece of land they felt was most suitable. **Mr. Burruel** will follow up with his Pima County contact to pursue permission for placing the art piece on the selected site.

In the meantime, **Ms. De La Cruz** will work on an RFP for the committee to discuss at a future meeting.

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

Ms. De La Cruz will have the RFP for El Rio completed.

ADJOURNMENT

Ms. De La Cruz asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Committee Member Fausto Burruel motioned to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Craig seconded the motion. Motion passed, 6-0. Meeting was adjourned at 4:15pm.
