GENERAL ORDER OF BUSINESS

A. Update and discussion regarding the proposed public art project at El Rio Preserve.

Ms. De La Cruz provided an update on the proposed public art project at El Rio Preserve. After speaking with Pima County staff, she explained that installing any artwork requiring digging or disturbance of the ground would be difficult.

The committee discussed alternative options, including utilizing property the town currently owns such as the fence, or the ramada that is already on-site. Ultimately, the committee agreed that members should visit the Preserve again to assess potential locations and determine the most suitable placement for an art installation and type of art.

B. Discussion and feedback on the location for the next public art project.

The committee discussed several options for the next public art project, including the Twin Peaks roundabout, the Loop extension, and potential landscaping improvements around the Falcon sculpture near the Amazon Warehouse. **Committee Member Wayne Barnett** agreed to seek input from the Parks and Recreation team regarding the most suitable location along the Loop for future artwork. In the meantime, the committee determined that the most appropriate course of action for this fiscal year is to proceed with landscape improvements to the existing Falcon sculpture. **Committee Member Wayne Barnett** will investigate what options there are for improving the area around the art installation.

Committee Member De La Cruz moved have the Parks Department look at the Falcon installation for possible landscaping improvements. Committee Member Angell seconded the motion. Motion passed 7-0

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

Ms. De La Cruz would like to discuss an art project for the Town's 50th Anniversary and **Committee Member Angell** proposed identifying the number of projects to fund next fiscal year.

ADJOURNMENT

Ms. De La Cruz asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Committee Member Hathaway motioned to adjourn the meeting. Committee Member Burrue seconded the motion. Motion passed, 7-0. Meeting was adjourned at 4:35pm.
