THIS AGREEMENT, including Attachments, between the City of Muskogee (Owner) and Holloway, Updike and Bellen, Inc. (Engineer);

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Owner intends to construct the following improvements:

PROJECT:

ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AT U.S. HIGHWAY 62 AND COUNTRY CLUB ROAD INTERSECTION: Professional Engineering services for the plans and specifications to:

- Widen Country Club Road north of U.S. 62 to three lanes to provide storage for dedicated left turn lane.
- Widen Country Club Road south of U.S. 62 to three lanes to provide dedicated left turn lane.
- Drainage improvements required to properly drain the project including offsite improvements on the south side of Shawnee from Country Club Road east to drainage channel.

WHEREAS, Owner requires certain engineering services (the Services) in connection with the Project; and,

WHEREAS, Engineer is prepared to provide the Services;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises contained in this Agreement, Owner and Engineer agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 - EFFECTIVE DATE The effective date of this Agreement shall be the _____ day of ________, 2018.

ARTICLE 2 - GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

ARTICLE 3 - SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY ENGINEER

Engineer shall perform the Services described in Attachment A, Scope of Services. During the construction phase, the Engineer shall be the Owner's agent and representative with respect to all services of the Engineer that are required or authorized by the construction documents.

ARTICLE 4 - COMPENSATION

Owner shall pay Engineer in accordance with Attachment B, Compensation.

ARTICLE 5 - OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Owner shall be responsible for all matters described in Attachment C, Owner's Responsibilities and Special Conditions.

ARTICLE 6 - STANDARD OF CARE

Engineer shall perform the Services undertaken in a manner consistent with the prevailing accepted standard for similar services with respect to projects of comparable function and complexity, and with the applicable laws and regulations published and in effect at the time of performance of the Services. Other than the obligation of the Engineer to perform in accordance with the foregoing standard, no warranty, either express or implied, shall apply to the Services to be performed by the Engineer pursuant to this Agreement or the suitability of Engineer's work product.

ARTICLE 7 - LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

- 7.1 <u>General.</u> Having considered the potential liabilities that may exist during the performance of the Services, the benefits of the Project, and the Engineer's fee for the Services; and in consideration of the promises contained in this Agreement, Owner and Engineer agree to allocate and limit such liabilities in accordance with this Article.
- 7.2 <u>Indemnification</u>. Engineer agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Owner, its agents and employees, from and against legal liability for all claims, losses, damages, and expenses to the extent such claims, losses, damages, or expenses are caused by its failure to perform its obligations under this agreement or by its negligent acts, errors, or omissions.
- 7.3 <u>Consequential Damages.</u> Neither Owner nor Engineer shall be liable to the other for any special, indirect, or consequential damages resulting in any way from the performance of the Services or this Agreement such as, but not limited to, loss of use, loss of revenue, or loss of anticipated profits.
- 7.4 <u>Survival.</u> Upon completion of all Services, obligations, and duties provided for in this Agreement, or if this Agreement is terminated for any reason, the terms and conditions of this Article shall survive.

ARTICLE 8 - INSURANCE

During the performance of the Services under this Agreement, Engineer shall maintain the following insurance:

- (1) General Liability Insurance, with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate.
- (2) Automobile Liability Insurance, with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 for each accident.

- (3) Workers' Compensation Insurance and Employer's liability Insurance in accordance with statutory requirements.
- (4) Professional Liability Insurance, with a limit of \$2,000,000 annual aggregate.

Engineer shall, upon written request, furnish Owner certificates of insurance which shall include a provision that such insurance shall not be canceled without at least thirty days' written notice to Owner. All Project contractors shall be required to include Owner and Engineer as additional insureds on their General Liability insurance policies, and shall be required to indemnify Owner and Engineer to the same extent.

ARTICLE 9 - LIMITATIONS OF RESPONSIBILITY

Engineer shall not be responsible for:(1) construction means, methods, techniques, sequences, procedures, or safety precautions and programs in connection with the Project; or (2) procuring permits, certificates, and licenses required for any construction unless such responsibilities are specifically assigned to Engineer in Attachment A, Scope of Services.

ARTICLE 10 - LIMITATIONS OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ACTS OF OTHERS

Provided that the Engineer has acted in good faith, Engineer shall not be liable to Owner for breach of contract or for negligent error or omission in failing to detect, prevent, or report the failure of any contractor, subcontractor, vendor, or other project participant to fulfill contractual or other responsibilities to the Owner, failure to finish or construct the Project in accordance with the plans and specifications, or failure to comply with federal, state, or local laws, ordinances, regulations, rules, codes, orders, criteria, or standards.

ARTICLE 11 - OPINIONS OF COST AND SCHEDULE

Since Engineer has no control over the cost of labor, materials, or equipment furnished by others, or over the resources provided by others to meet Project schedules, Engineer's opinion of probable costs and of Project schedules shall be made on the basis of experience and qualifications as a professional engineer. Engineer does not guarantee that proposals, bids, or actual Project costs will conform to Engineer's cost estimates or that actual schedules will conform to Engineer's projected schedules. Engineer shall complete the services within the time frame outlined on Attachment D, Schedule, subject to conditions which are beyond the control of the Engineer.

ARTICLE 12 - REUSE OF DOCUMENTS

All documents, including, but not limited to, drawings, specifications, and computer software prepared by Engineer pursuant to this Agreement are instruments of service in respect to the Project. They are not intended or represented to be suitable for reuse by Owner or others on extensions of the Project or on any other project. Any reuse without prior written verification or adaptation by Engineer for the specific purpose intended will be at Owner's sole risk and without liability or legal exposure to Engineer. Owner shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Engineer against all claims, losses, damages, injuries, and expenses, including attorneys' fees, arising out of or resulting from such reuse. Any verification or adaptation of documents will entitle Engineer to additional compensation at rates to be agreed upon by Owner and Engineer.

ARTICLE 13 - OWNERSHIP OF DOCUMENTS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Except as otherwise provided herein, engineering documents, drawings, and specifications prepared by Engineer as part of the Services shall become the property of Owner provided, however, that Engineer shall have the unrestricted right to their use. Engineer shall retain its rights in its standard drawing details, specifications, data bases, computer software, and other proprietary property. Rights to intellectual property developed, utilized, or modified in the performance of the Services shall remain the property of Engineer. The Owner may use said documents for their own use at no cost to the Owner.

ARTICLE 14 - TERMINATION

This Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice in the event of substantial failure by the other party to perform in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. The nonperforming party shall have fifteen calendar days from the date of the termination notice to cure or to submit a plan for cure acceptable to the other party.

Owner may terminate or suspend performance of this Agreement for Owner's convenience upon written notice to Engineer. Engineer shall terminate or suspend performance of the Services on a schedule acceptable to Owner. If termination or suspension is for Owner's convenience, Owner shall pay Engineer for all the Services performed and termination or suspension expenses in such amount as agreed upon by the Owner and Engineer.

ARTICLE 15 - DELAY IN PERFORMANCE

Neither Owner nor Engineer shall be considered in default of this Agreement for delays in performance caused by circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the nonperforming party. For purposes of this Agreement, such circumstances include, but are not limited to, abnormal weather conditions; floods, earthquakes, fire; epidemics; war, riots, and other civil disturbances; strikes, lockouts, work slowdowns, and other labor disturbances; sabotage; judicial restraint; and inability to procure permits, licenses, or authorizations from any local, state, or federal agency for any of the supplies, materials, accesses, or services required to be provided by either Owner or Engineer under this Agreement.

Should such circumstances occur, the nonperforming party shall, within a reasonable time of being prevented from performing, give written notice to the other party describing the circumstances preventing continued performance and the efforts being made to resume performance of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 16 - COMMUNICATIONS

Any communication required by this Agreement shall be made in writing to the addresses specified below with a copy to the Owner's attorney:

Nothing contained in this Article shall be construed to restrict the transmission of routine communications between representatives of Engineer and Owner.

ARTICLE 17 - WAIVER

A waiver by either Owner or Engineer of any breach of this Agreement shall be in writing. Such a waiver shall not affect the waiving party's rights with respect to any other or further breach.

ARTICLE 18 - SEVERABILITY

The invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement or the occurrence of any event rendering any portion or provision of this Agreement void shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of any other portion or provision of this Agreement. Any void provision shall be deemed severed from this Agreement, and the balance of this Agreement shall be construed and enforced as if this Agreement did not contain the particular portion or provision held to be void. The parties further agree to amend this Agreement to replace any stricken provision with a valid provision that comes as close as possible to the intent of the stricken provision. The provisions of this Article shall not prevent this entire Agreement from being void should a provision which is of the essence of this Agreement be determined void.

ARTICLE 19 - INTEGRATION

This Agreement represents the entire and integrated Agreement between Owner and Engineer. It supersedes all prior and contemporaneous communications, representations, and agreements, whether oral or written, relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.

ARTICLE 20 - SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS

To the extent permitted by Article 21, Owner and Engineer each binds itself and its successors and assigns to the other party to this Agreement.

ARTICLE 21 - ASSIGNMENT

Neither Owner nor Engineer shall assign its duties under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party. Unless otherwise stated in the written consent to an assignment, no assignment will release or discharge the assignor from any obligation under this Agreement. Nothing contained in this Article shall prevent Engineer from employing independent consultants, associates, and subcontractors to assist in the performance of the Services.

ARTICLE 22 - THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to give any rights or benefits to anyone other than Owner and Engineer.

ARTICLE 23 – AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED

The Owner will issue the Engineer a written "Notice to Proceed" as authorization to proceed with the work.

Once the legislature recesses this session with whatever amendments pass, we will begin amending ordinances to bring our own into compliance for what will be allowed.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS AND FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE FOR INTERIM LICENSING OF THE SALE OF STRONG BEER AND WINE BY CERTAIN RETAILERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 37A, OKLAHOMA STATUTES

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2016, Oklahoma voters approved SQ 792, which repealed Article 28 of the Oklahoma Constitution governing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages and replaced it with Article 28A, reforming such processes; and

WHEREAS, said constitutional referendum facilitated the adoption of Title 37A of Oklahoma Statutes, effective October 1, 2018, which among other things, will permit the sale of strong beer and wine in convenience and grocery stores; and

WHEREAS, part of the implementation of Title 37A, the State of Oklahoma, through the Alcoholic Beverage Licensing and Enforcement Commission ("ABLE Commission"), has commenced the issuance of "interim licenses" to such retailers; and

WHEREAS, The ABLE licensing process requires the submission of "Certificate of Compliance from the city or county where the business is located stating all building codes for zoning, fire, safety, and health are in compliance or are not required"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish an administrative process and fee for the issuance of such a certificates by the City Clerk during the interim period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council that the City Manager is hereby directed to establish within 10 days of the issuance of this resolution, an administrative process for the issuance of a "Certificate of Compliance" in accordance with Title 37A, Oklahoma Statutes, and any other regulation promulgated and adopted by the ABLE Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the fee for issuance of such "Certificate of Compliance" shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per location.

Text to 9-1-1 project

Citizens Connected, Text to 9-1-1 Project summary

In our society today virtually everyone carries a cell phone. In fact over 78% of the 9-1-1 calls received at the Muskogee City County E9-1-1 Communications Center are from cell phone callers. The use of texting to keep in contact with friends, relatives and business contacts has become common place, many times even replacing voice calls as the choice way to communicate. For hearing or speech impaired individuals texting by cell phone has eliminated the need for them to be tethered to a landline teletype device or TTD. Success in the use of 9-1-1 as a way to contact emergency services has been due to the ease to remember the three digit number and universal access from all telephone devices, ie; landline, voice over internet protocol VoIP phones and cell phones. However not having access to the use of texting to report emergencies to 9-1-1 has put up a road block to the universal access to 9-1-1 the public has come to rely on and expect. Lack of Text to 9-1-1 makes access to 9-1-1 unavailable to individuals who are speech and hearing impaired if they do not have a TTD landline available to them. According to the CDC's National Center of Health Statistics 2017 report, 51% of American households no longer have landline phones. Imagine the frustration knowing you can text an Uber or order pizza but contacting emergency services is unavailable to you.

This project will resolve the equal access issue and make 9-1-1 again the universal number to contact 9-1-1 for all individuals in the City of Muskogee, hearing and hearing impaired alike. This service will enhance everyone's access to emergency services; provide opportunities to allow notification of the need of emergency assistance when it's unsafe for callers to speak, such as domestic violence, hostage or active shooter situations. One of the most recent events that text to 9-1-1 would have helped in locating and getting help to victims was at the Pulse Night Club in Orland when an active shooter killed 49 persons and wounded another 58. Orlando did not at that time have text to 9-1-1 and unable to make voice calls to 9-1-1 sent text messages to friends and family with their location and information about the shooter that could have been helpful to save lives by giving intel that would allow law enforcement to locate and stop the shooter more quickly.

As Text to 9-1-1 has been made available in other areas stories of lives saved and positive outcomes are reported; help received with-out delay, peace of mind given to those reliant on text only as a means of communication. We know from the statistics over 3% Oklahomans are deaf, we are aware of situations involving the residents we serve that Text to 9-1-1 here will provide the same success stories we have seen in other areas that have implemented this service. Text to 9-1-1 will help not just hearing or speech impaired persons it will help anyone that needs a secondary method to summon emergency services to their aid. Voice calls to 9-1-1 will still remain the primary method of contact to 9-1-1 and we will strongly encourage the continued use of voice calls to 9-1-1 for those that can use it as a their primary method to contact us. To aid in this we will use the National campaign of Call 9-1-1 if you can, Text 9-1-1 if you cant. However the assurance of equal access to all our residents and visitors to emergency services is at the core of basic need for our being here as the link between those in need and those who help.

According the National Institute on Deafness and Other Communications Disorders, approximately 16% of the population of the United States suffer from some type of hearing loss. More specifically for Oklahoma a 2017 report from the National Deaf Center On Postsecondary Outcomes found that 3.8% of Oklahoman's age 25 to 64 years old are deaf. For us that would represent a population of over 1,400 deaf persons in the city of Muskogee and over 2,600 deaf persons for all of Muskogee County.

Currently we only provide a means for voice calls to 9-1-1 or for deaf persons they have to use a ttd/tty devise that is required to be hooked up to a landline telephone service. However, a 2017 Centers For Disease Control (CDC) National Center for Health Statistics report found 51% of American households no longer have a landline phone. Landline phone calls simply are not the way anyone communicates today, especially someone that is deaf. Because wireless phones provide texting between everyone, it has become the communications option of choice for deaf individuals. This has created a disparaging service and lack of access to 9-1-1 for these individuals. Making them less likely to report crimes or incidents of crime against them and making them more at risk to be a victim of crime. This project would remedy this disparity and provide equal access to all our citizens. This project will also provide additional means of access to 9-1-1 for everyone, giving another way to request assistance in times when it's not safe to speak or should an individual become unable to vocalize their need for emergency services. A clear and measureable successful outcome of this project will be in the number of Text to 9-1-1 calls we will receive, allowing us to measure the incidents that would have otherwise been delayed or would have gone unreported.

The geographic area the 911 Call Center serves is all of Muskogee County. The demographics of the service area. According to U.S. Census Bureau July 1, 2016 population estimates, the population of the County is 69,477 and the population of the City is 38,352. The demographic profile of the service population is White 60.6%, African American 11.0%, Native American 19.0% and Hispanic 6.0%. The poverty rate in the service area for all families is 21.4%. The number of people served in the past year is over 110,000 calls for service but have processed over 200,000 calls from the public.

To enable Text to 9-1-1 we must contract with a national data service provider who interfaces our 9-1-1 call taking equipment with the wireless carriers by means of networking and software data exchanges. The service dates for this project and grant would be July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023. The service provider West Safety Services offers this service to us with the cost spread out over a multi year option. The first year we are requesting \$12,825 to cover the setup cost billed from the service provider then a annual cost of four years there after of \$5,700 to cover the connectivity and service cost. The term of the contract with the vendor requires a five year commitment. We will then use our own staff for project management and training of dispatch staff, and as well utilize current dispatch staff to provide the service as part of their regular duties.
