City Attorney Roy Tucker stated the URA is governed by a five (5) member board, with one (1) member serving from each of the four (4) wards and the final member serving at-large within the City. After the URA was established, the City Council adopted a Uniform Appointment Procedure for the filling of vacancies on the boards and commissions of the City. Through this procedure, each member is given an appointment on a rotating basis, with those having the most seniority making the first appointments. As applicable to the URA, as this procedure is being implemented, Council members are assigned appointments for representatives of other members' wards. Staff has fielded several calls on the matter and this appears to be an unintended consequence of the Uniform Appointment Procedure. Therefore, Staff has proposed a modification to the URA ordinance which will allow Representatives of the respective wards to make appointments within their wards.

City Attorney Roy Tucker stated two (2) years ago, the voters approved State Question 792 with an effective date of October 1, 2018. The new law has created a number of new categories for which occupational taxes may be levied, as well as, removed the category of Low-Point Beer. In April 2018, the City passed a resolution creating an Interim Licensing Program which would allow retailers to be able to purchase and stock strong beer and wine in anticipation of the October 1, 2018, effective date. Now that the deadline is approaching, it is necessary to take steps to begin amending our existing ordinances to incorporate changes in the law. Proposed Ordinance 4055-A incorporates new definitions and categories of occupational taxes for the selling of beer (strong) and wine.

City Attorney Roy Tucker stated the attached resolution will establish the occupational tax for all categories of the sale of wine, beer, and spirits within the City. This a compendium item to the previous ordinance. Mr. Tucker distributed a schedule of the proposed fees, as well as a comparison of the fees charged in Oklahoma City and Norman. He explained some of the challenges faced are the Ordinances are so new, they cannot be found in Municode. One of the provisions in the occupancy tax is that municipalities are not permitted to charge more than what the State charges. The proposed fees presented to Council are those which are the same amount that was charged by the State of Oklahoma. Attorney Tucker discussed the fees in detail.

Councilmember Marlon Coleman questioned why the proposed fees were higher in Muskogee than Norman and Oklahoma City.

Attorney Tucker stated it has a lot to do with volume. He explained Oklahoma City and Norman are going to have many more individuals that will be applying, so the tax those cities are going to recognize will be more, even if the amount is lower; when this was brought forth, Muskogee followed what the State would allow.

Councilmember Coleman asked how soon the Resolution needed to be passed.

Attorney Tucker stated as soon as possible, but if there needed to be delay, it could be brought back to a Special Call meeting.

Councilmember Johnson stated he is comfortable with the fees. He understands they seem high, but he feels businesses will quickly recoup this fee.

Councilmember Patrick Cale stated the fees that concern Councilmembers Coleman and Johnson are close to the fees of Oklahoma City and Norman.

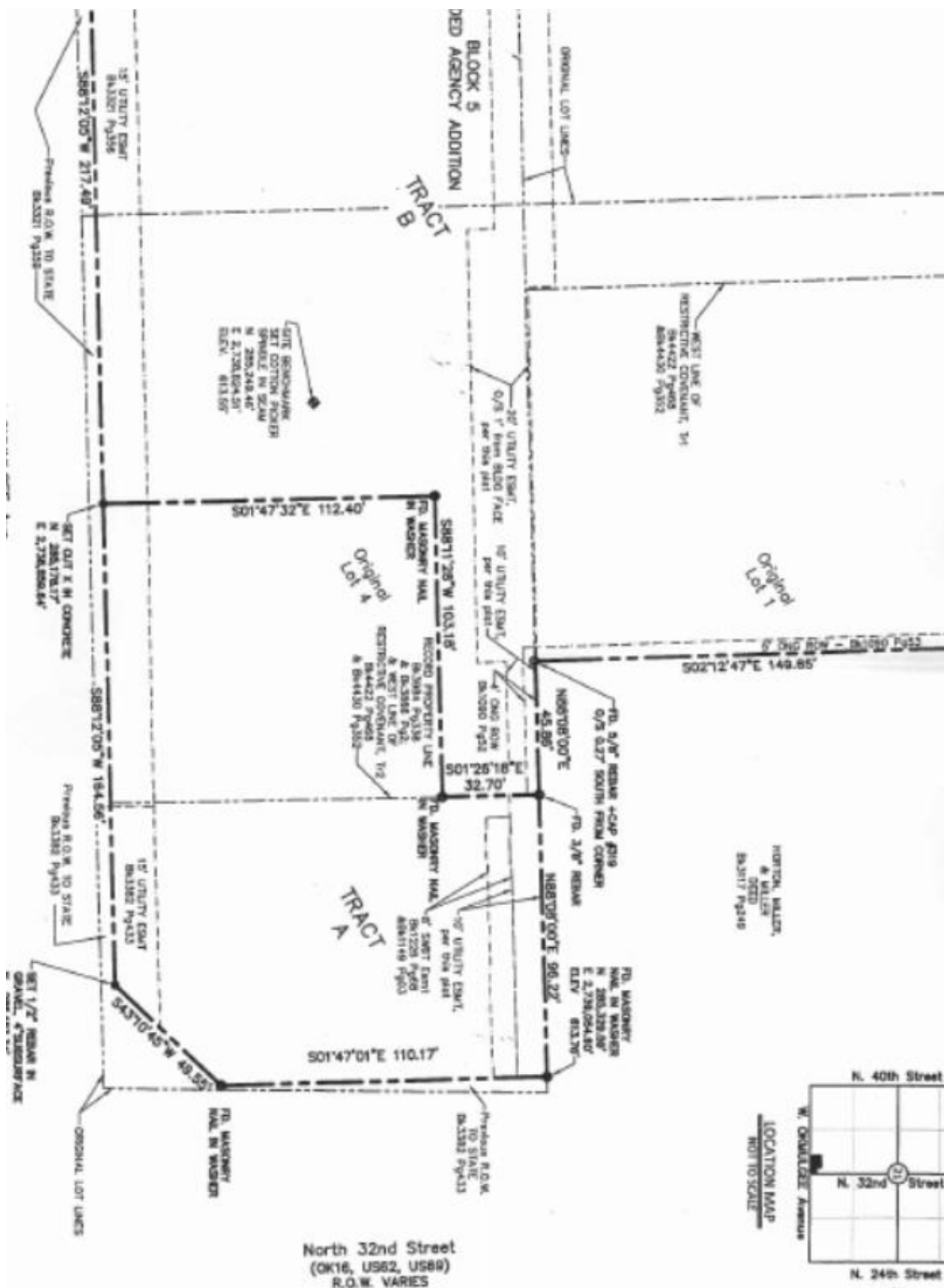
