Officer Matt Burleson stated the Muskogee Police Department remains to be a leader in the community by constantly evolving its policies and procedures to better serve the citizens of Muskogee. The addition of the Faro Laser Scanning camera system would enable the Police Department to work alongside multiple agencies and various departments within the City to better assist in the preservation of evidence, map school escape routes during active shooter situations, mapping historical buildings within the City to enable virtual tours, and investigate arsons with the ability to reconstruct fires. The Faro camera also allows the operator to map and chart traffic conditions within the City, while also providing the ability to reconstruct injury and fatality accidents to scale. The ability of the camera to take millions of points of interest is an asset that is invaluable. These are examples of the power and impact that this technology could bring to this geographical area.

The Faro scanning technology is supported by the Muskogee District Attorney's Office, which lends their support for this advancement in the Police Department. The Faro scanning camera will be utilized in jury trials and preliminary hearings to enhance criminal case presentation. Jurors will now have the ability to take a virtual tour through a crime scene.

The breakdown is as follows:

- 1. Focus S 70, with HDR photography, GPS, compass, altimeter (barometer), dual-axis compensator, WLAN, IP rating 54, 1x Battery Power Block, 1x Battery Power Dock, 1x 90W Power Supply, 1x Optic Cleaning Fluid, 3x Optic Cleaning Tissues, 1x 32GB SD card, 1x SD card reader, 1x SD card cover, 1x rugged transport case, calibration certificate, 1 year manufacturer guarantee and a quick start guide. **Total: \$31,899.95**
- 2. 3D_AC_LS_Standard Carbon Fiber Tripod Super lightweight, highly stable, low-vibration, tailored carbon fiber tripod for perfect performance and increased durability <u>Total: \$847.81</u>
- 3. 3D SCENE software is designed for viewing, administration, and for extensive work on 3D scan points. It allows the user to manipulate raw 3D scan points and acquire with analysis functions initial point cloud data comprehension. It is a complete workspace creation and manipulation tool and contains all functionality of FARO Scout plus functions required for scan. **Total: \$4,616.98**
- 4. FARO Zone 3D Advanced version of FARO Zone 3D is used to create 2D and 3D scene diagrams and animations, perform crash and crime scene analysis, create impressive courtroom presentations, open diagrams created with other FARO Forensics software, import point clouds captured by drones and laser scanners, and directly open SCENE software projects. This includes one (1) year of maintenance with product updates and upgrades (as available) and top tier technical support. **Total: \$5,293.69**
- 5. A three (3) day course for two (2) trainees at an approved FARO training facility that discusses LS operation, setup, and basic measurements. NOTE: Classroom trainings are limited to six (6) trainees and are scheduled on a first come first serve basis. Classes can be canceled within two (2) weeks of the scheduled date if sufficient enrollment is not met. NOTE: Training will expire if not taken within 90-days of receipt of equipment. No charge, applicable only with purchase of Laser Scanner. **Total: \$0.00**
