INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING CONTRACTORS PRE-QUALIFICATION APPLICATION

Contractors shall be prequalified by the Contractor's Prequalification Board in accordance with Ordinance 4091-A in order to be considered for award of any City of Muskogee construction project greater than \$50,000.

Financial information requested herein is not subject to public disclosure pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

The Prequalification Application must be filled out in accordance with all instructions. An incomplete application may result in rejection of the application.

Applications for Prequalification will be approved by the City of Muskogee Contractor's Prequalification Board. Any bidder not satisfied with the findings of the Prequalification Board may file an appeal with the City Clerk asking for a review of the Board's conclusions of the Contractor's application. This appeal must be filed within ten (10) calendar days of notice of the refusal.

It is the Contractor's responsibility to resubmit this form to the City of Muskogee should there be any changes in company ownership or financial standing. Failure to do so may result in revocation of prequalification.

Because the City of Muskogee uses ODOT Specifications for public improvements involving street work, bridge work, and traffic control, only applicants that possess an ODOT CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION OF QUALIFICATION or ODOT Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) Certification shall be eligible to submit an application for a Certificate of Competency to bid street work within the City of Muskogee.

In the result of a conflict between these instructions and Ordinance 4091-A, the language of the Ordinance shall control.

CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY

After final action by the Contractor's Prequalification Board in prequalifying a contractor, the Board shall issue to the approved contractor a Certificate of Competency. The certificate shall contain the work classification(s) approved by the Board and the expiration date.

FEES

There is hereby established an initial non-refundable fee in the amount of \$200.00 for the processing of applications and the issuance of a Certificate of Competency. Certificates shall be valid for up to one (1) fiscal year (July 1st – June 30th.) Certificates shall be renewable on July 1st of each year for a fee in the amount of \$100.00. Failure to renew will result in the contractor's prequalification status being changed to inactive until the Board receives and approves said renewal. The renewal is contingent on the applicant continuing to meet requirements as reviewed by the Board. Provided however, there shall be no application fee required on projects which involve Federal or State agencies prohibiting payment of such fees.

PREQUALIFICATION STATUS

The Board may, with proper notice and a hearing, reduce, suspend or revoke the contractor's prequalification status at any time based on the contractor's performance record with regard to quality of work, timely completion, debarment by others, changed financial status, failure to secure bond, failure to pay subcontractors and/or suppliers, or other pertinent factors.

In such cases, the contractor shall be notified in writing of the proposed action to be taken and an opportunity for a hearing on such action by the Board.
