#### **BACKGROUND:**

The City's Agreement with Cebridge Acquisition L.P., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications, is set to expire October 8, 2025. Cebridge Acquisition has been acquired by Altice, USA, d/b/a Optimum. Generally, the City would have held a public hearing to consider a 5-year extension of the Agreement; however, due to the changes which occurred in the recent transfer of ownership of the cable company, an agreement with Altice, USA, d/b/a Optimum must be created. This extension allowing Altice, USA, d/b/a Optimum to continue providing cable vision services provides an opportunity for the City to hold a public hearing, and gain useful public input, and incorporate necessary input into a renewed agreement. The agreement is non-exclusive, so this extension of the renewed agreement does not disallow another provider from providing cable vision services.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 4277-A**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MUSKOGEE GRANTING A NINETY (90) DAY EXTENSION OF THE CABLE PROVIDER FRANCHISE GRANTED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 4106-A, BY PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ordinance No. 4106-A, adopted October 5, 2020, the City of Muskogee, Oklahoma, ("City") granted a cable television franchise to Cebridge Acquisition, L.P. d/b/a Suddenlink Communications ("Suddenlink") for a period of five (5) years, which is set to expire on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2025. and

WHEREAS, Altice USA, d/b/a Optimum, has since acquired Cebridge Acquisition, L.P. and the City is in the process of negotiating Altice, USA a renewal of the Franchise, and both parties desire to extend the Franchise for an additional ninety (90) day period;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the City, as hereinafter set out:

**SECTION 1**: The City hereby extends the Franchise for an additional ninety (90) days beginning on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2025 and ending on the January 7, 2026.

**SECTION 2:** Cebridge d/b/a Suddenlink is the current holder of the right, privilege and authority granted pursuant to the Franchise and it has been acquired by Altice USA, d/b/a Optimum; and in no way does this Ordinance diminish the cable provider's rights and privileges to seek a franchise renewal pursuant to Section 626 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 546, including but not limited to its notice of intent to renew the Franchise filed pursuant to a letter from Altice to the City.

**SECTION 3:** Except as amended hereby, the Franchise shall remain in full force and effect subject to prevailing federal, state, and local law and is hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects.

**SECTION 4:** EMERGENCY. An immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the and after passage, approval and publication or posting.
