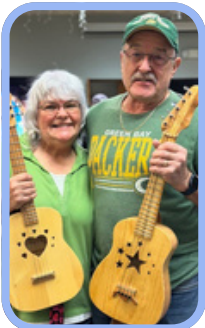

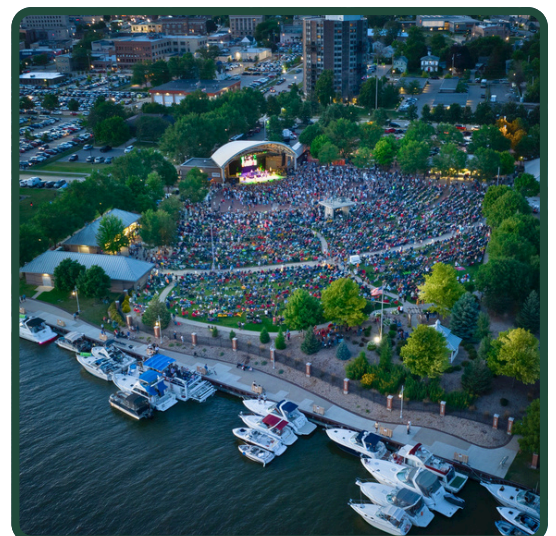

- 86% of organizers saw an increase in attendance in 2025, an 18% increase from 2024
- 2025 ranks as the second-highest year for special events since 2011, and the highest since pre-COVID (2018)

## Project Highlights

- Replanted landscaping at Riverside Cemetery Chapel
- Planted 1,100 tulips in Opera House Square
- Renovated the zoo picnic area landscaping using donated plants from McKay Garden Center
- Helped Quarry Park Neighborhood Association plant over 800 marigolds on the terrace at Quarry Park on Knapp St
- 60 trees were planted with the help of volunteers, including Governor Tony Evers
- Installed the fifth gateway sign and landscaping at the roundabout on Jackson St. and Murdock Ave
- Updated all gateway sign bases from faux rock to solid blue

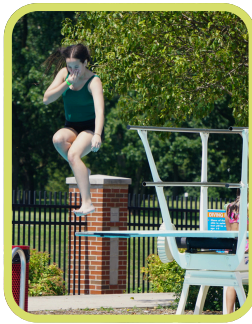

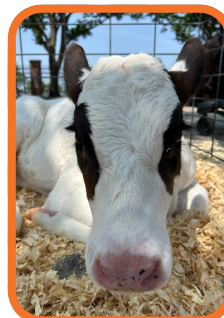
