# APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Consider approving the minutes from the May 28, 2025 Meeting of the Tourism Advisory Board.

Motion made by Daniel Hennessee to approve the minutes as presented and seconded by Michael Nichols.

#### **DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS**

1. Discussion and possible action regarding the formation of an America250 planning committee.

Discussion regarding the formation of the board and proposed members. Board members Cristy Buckner and Michael Nichols volunteered to be on the planning committee. Quarterly updates should be made to the Tourism Advisory Board.

Motion made by Daniel Hennessee to authorize formation of the committee to plan a 2-3 day event in 2026 for the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of America's Independence Day. The motion was seconded by Cristy Buckner.

#### Upon vote, the motion carried with a 6-0 unanimous vote.

2. Discussion and possible action regarding a Hotel Occupancy Tax Funding Grant for Palestine ISD for an event scheduled on September 4-5, 2025.

Discussion related to granting additional funds for marketing support.

A motion was made by Daniel Hennessee to grant the Hotel Occupancy Tax event funding plus an additional \$6000 for marketing support as a reimbursement grant for expenses related to marketing the event. The motion was seconded by Cristy Buckner.

3. Discussion and possible action regarding a Hotel Occupancy Tax Funding Grant for Palestine YMCA for an event scheduled for July 12, 2025.

Kasey Crutcher recused himself from discussion due to a conflict of interest, as he serves on the board for the Palestine YMCA at 4:17 pm.

Discussion about providing additional funds for marketing support.

A motion was made by Edward Mondich to grant the Hotel Occupancy Tax event funding plus an additional \$1000 for marketing support as a reimbursement grant for expenses related to marketing the event. The motion was seconded by Michael Nichols.

Upon vote, the motion carried with a 5-0 vote. Board Member Kasey Crutcher abstained from the vote.

Kasey Crutcher rejoined the meeting at 4:23 pm.

4. Discussion and possible action related to a proposal for the Huey Helicopter Project.

Mayor Jordan presented information related to the project and there was discussion about the budget and plans related to the project.

Motion made by Daniel Hennessee to grant \$12,000 for the installation of the helicopter, pending the following conditions are met:

- a. Confirmation of legality of the spend by the City Attorney and the Texas Hotel & Lodging Association legal council.
- b. Grant of space at the Veterans Memorial Park by City Council.

The motion was seconded by Kasey Crutcher.

Upon vote, the motion carried with a 6-0 unanimous vote.
