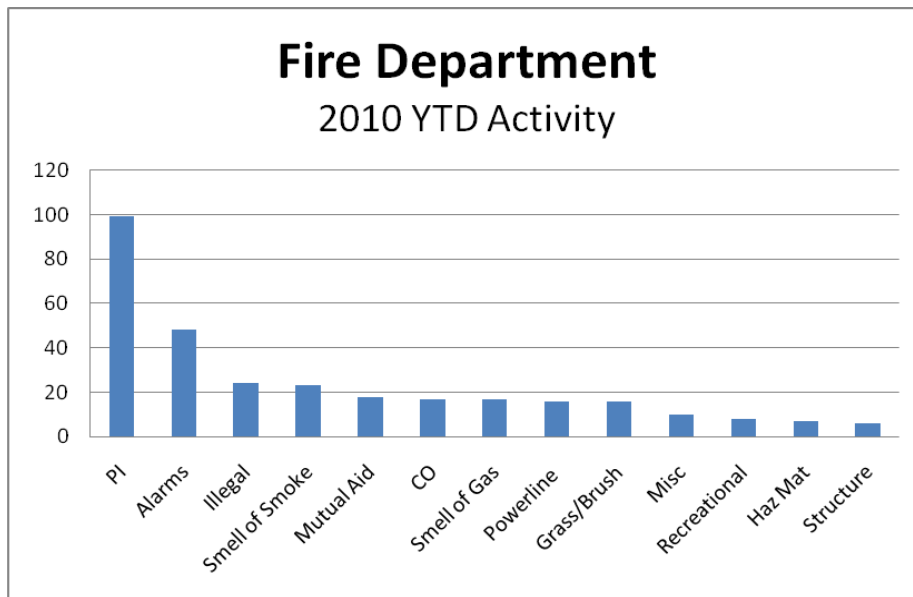
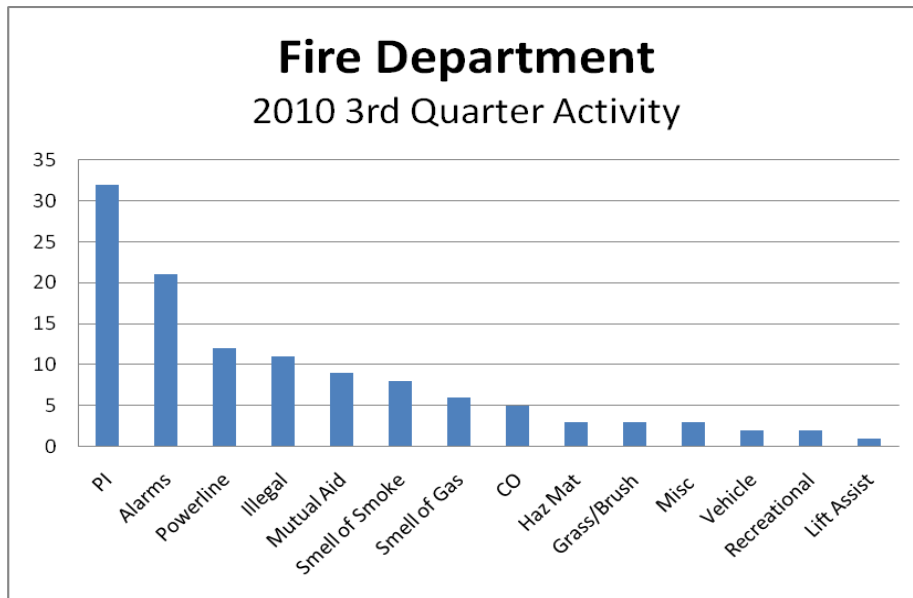


Ramsey Fire Department 3rd Quarter Report 2010

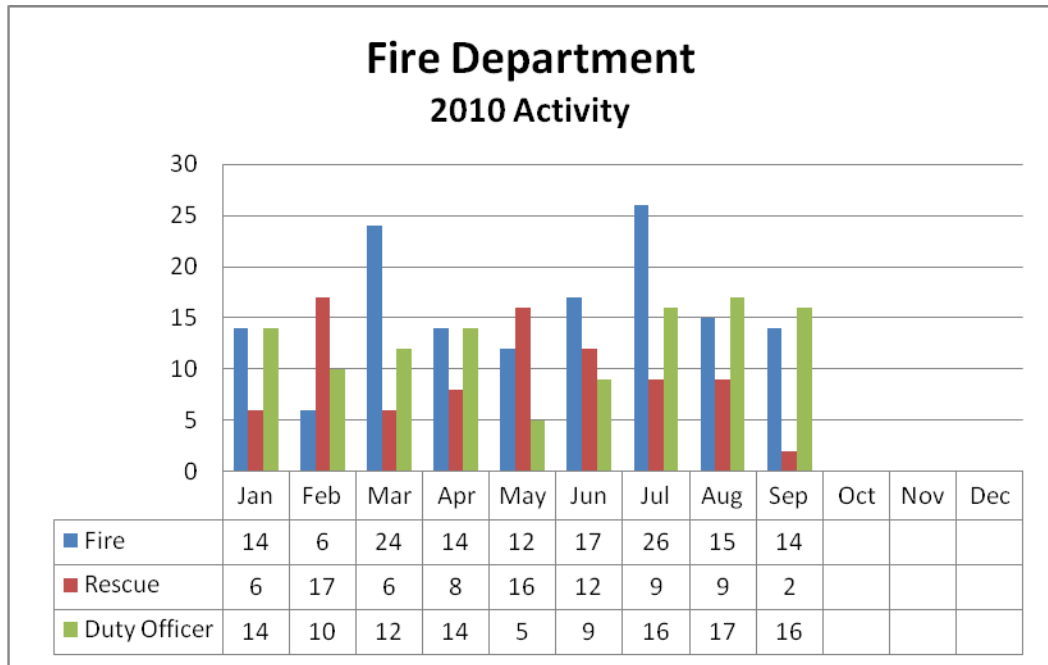
Responses

The third quarter of 2010 found the Fire Department responding to 124 calls for service. This compares to 107 for the 2nd quarter. Of the 124 calls, 17 were calls to the Nowthen service area. The third quarter included 2 vehicle fire, 32 personal injury accidents (including 2 extrications), 9 calls for mutual aid, and 1 structure fire in Ramsey. Below are charts illustrating the different types of calls and quantities for both 3rd quarter and YTD:

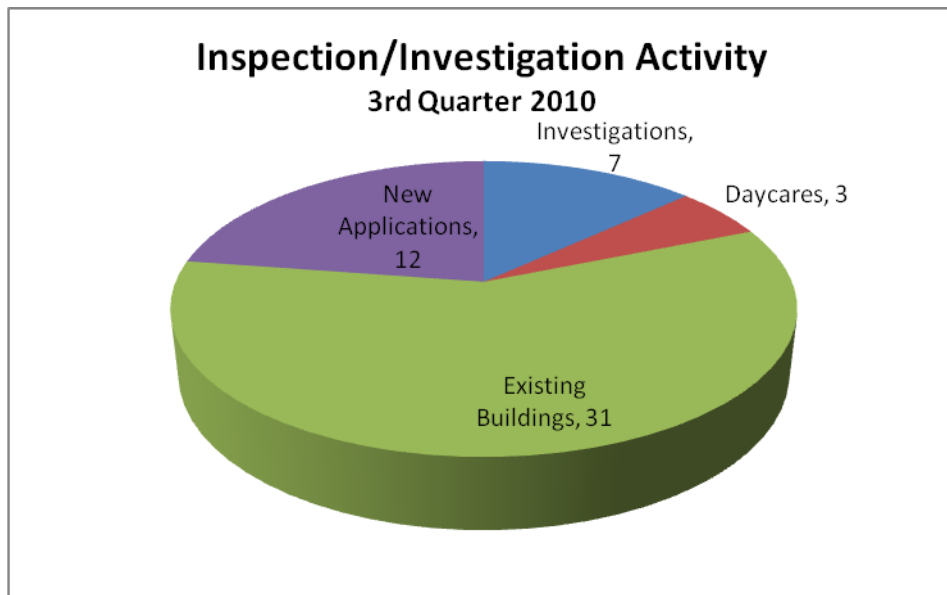


Activity Categories

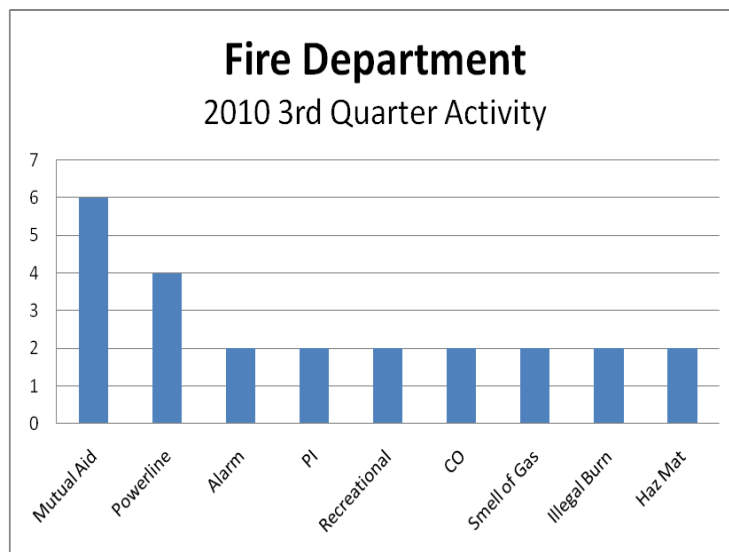
