RESOLUTION RELATED TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR THE DYSPROSIUM STREET NW RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, STATE AID PROJECT 199-110-006

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey has planned the improvement of Dysprosium Street NW, State Aid Route No. 199-110-006 from Bunker Lake Boulevard (CSAH 116) to Nowthen Boulevard (CSAH 5) in the City of Ramsey, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey will be expending Municipal State Aid Funds on the improvement of this street; and

WHEREAS, this improvement does not provide adequate width for parking on both sides of the street; and approval of the proposed construction as a Municipal State Aid Street project must therefore be conditioned upon certain parking restrictions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

That the City of Ramsey shall ban the parking of motor vehicles on the east side of Dysprosium Street NW at all times.
