RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR CITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #11-21; ARMSTRONG AND BUNKER LAKE BOULEVARD INTERSECTION SIGNALIZATON

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2010 the Ramsey City Council ordered improvement project 11-21; Armstrong and Bunker Lake Boulevard Signalization Project; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2011 the Ramsey City Council called for the preparation of plans and specifications when they awarded of an engineering services contract with WSB & Associates; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2011 the Ramsey City Council authorized the solicitation of bids; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement for bids for Improvement Project 11-21; Armstrong and Bunker Lake Boulevard Intersection Signalization, bids were received, opened and tabulated according to law; and

WHEREAS, the following is a summary of the bids that were received:
