RESOLUTION APPOINTING COUNCILMEMBER TOSSEY TO SERVE AS THE PRIMARY COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE JOINT LAW ENFORCEMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS, at the first meeting in January of each year, the City Council adopts a Council Organization resolution naming representatives and alternates to the City's committees and boards; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Resolution #11-01-001 titled Council Organization on January 4, 2011, ; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Jeffrey was appointed as the primary Council representative to the Joint Law Enforcement Council; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Jeffrey resigned his position as Councilmember, effective June 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, a new primary representative needs to be appointed to the Joint Law Enforcement Council; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Tossey was originally appointed as the alternate to the Joint Law Enforcement Council and would serve as the primary representative; and

WHEREAS, a replacement alternate representative shall be appointed at a subsequent Council meeting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1) That the City Council hereby appoints Councilmember Tossey to serve as the primary Council representative to the Joint Law Enforcement Council.
