Food Vendors

Background:

Last year we had a total of four food vendors for the Happy Days Festival: Acapulco Restaurante Mexicano, Well's Catering, Domino's Pizza, and the Ramsey Lions's Club. The carnival also had a food stand providing the traditional carnival foods. The Happy Days members that were present stated they were very happy with the food stand from last year and suggested asking the same vendors to come back again this year.

Rick Chubb stated that he spoke to the owner of Domino's Pizza and reminded him about the donation they still owe the city. As of the February meeting, we are still waiting for a check.

Rachel from Acapulco dropped off a check for their donation and stated they would be willing to have a food stand on Friday night, as well as all day Saturday.

Councilmember Elvig suggested that we go out for RFP's for food vendors and also require food vendors to provide a deposit. Additionally, he suggested that all food vendors provide a portion size for every item sold.

Councilmember Elvig stated that he would be willing to help with this process.

Northgate Church Donation - Carnival versus Inflatable Package

Background:

Wayne Skaff of Northgate Church attended the February meeting and presented Northgate Church's donation of \$5,000 toward one ride at the carnival or \$5,000 towards an inflatable package which includes the very popular euro bungee jump. He stated that Northgate Church would like a sign recognizing them as the sponsor of the ride/rides.

The Committee informed Mr. Skaff that a donation of that amount would be considered an Exclusive Sponsorship at the Platinum level and that they would most definitely have a sign.

Mr. Skaff stated that he has done some research and one possible package of inflatables-including the very popular euro bungee jump, for one day - 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., would cost approximately \$5,200, including insurance and staffing.

One suggestion was to have the inflatables available for the Friday Family Fun Night as well Saturday. There were a couple of draw backs to this suggestion, cost, set-up on Friday, and staffing both during the event and overnight.

The Committee asked Wayne Skaff to get a quote for the inflatable package to include Friday night from 6:00 to 10:00 p.m.

Attached is a copy of the contract from USA Inflatables for the rental of - 1-4 Station euro Bungee, 2-15 X 15 Moonwalks, 1-18' Double Bay Slide, 1-65' Rock climb Challenge Obstacle Course, 1-25' Rock Climb – 11 staff member for 13 hours each. USA Inflatables will also set up and staff a 10 X 10 tent to answer questions from customers and make sure the event runs smoothly.

The total cost for the above package is \$7,310. USA Inflatables will also require 7-20 amp curcuits - provided by the City.

1. **MAPS** USA Inflatables requests maps of the game layout before event, for quicker set up.
2. **SITE** Games can be placed indoors or outdoors. NO DIRT or GRAVEL! We prefer grass. Asphalt and cement are ok as long as we know up front so that extra set up and tear down time can be allowed to set up tarps, carpets, and sand bags.
3. **SITE SPECIFICATIONS** USA Inflatables must be able to back truck up to within ten feet of the event site. All of the games must be within a reasonable vicinity of each other in order for the operators to supervise the attractions. The operators must have a freight elevator for any second story locations without exception. A ramp must be provided for any steps (MAXIMUM 3 steps) to reach the site of the engagement. USA Inflatables requires one parking space for one 14' delivery van within 100' of the site at all times before during and after the event.
4. **OUTDOOR** USA Inflatables must be able to drive delivery vans on grass. Many games are simply too heavy to carry with a dolly and require a vehicle with a trailer to move the attraction to desired location. Extra outdoor Power outlets are helpful. 20 amp circuits are required. If required, USA Inflatables will supply generators at additional costs.
5. **BLOWER & ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS:** Each inflatable requires a blower that runs constantly. Each blower requires one 20 amp circuit within 100' of inflatable. Some exceptions do apply..... The Titanic and our 60' obstacle course requires 2 blowers and two 20 amp circuits. Because of its extremely large size, the Pirates Cove and Kongs Revenge requires 3 blowers and would need three 20 amp circuits. USA Inflatables can supply generators at additional costs. USA Inflatables is not liable for items not being utilized because of inadequate power supply. Delays in set-up will be billed to customer.
6. **SETUP** When a customer requests a discount by providing helpers (assistants) for set up and or take down, USA Inflatables will require the assistance of FOUR to SIX persons for approximately one hour for both the load-in (1 hours prior to event start time) and the load out (at end of event) of the equipment. NOTE: Titanic, Pirates Cove, and the giant slide requires, SIX to EIGHT persons, for both the load-in and load-out of the equipment. If customer does not have the required number of assistants then it may take longer to unload the trucks and setup the equipment possibly causing a delay in the event start time. Mechanical equipment such as forklifts and hand trucks are helpful but not required.
7. **ASSISTANCE FOR SHOW** (NOTE: If USA Inflatables is contracted to fully staff and operate each game with our crew, this section will not apply to your group) The numbers of assistants the customer will need to supply is 1-4 operators on each individual game. Most games require 2-3 operators. If the number of assistants required are not provided or leave during the event, then USA Inflatables will have to shut down or eliminate one or more games with no reduction in the agreed price. This is not negotiable as our insurance requires that we have adequate supervision of all games at all times! Assistants need to be present prior to start time to receive operating & safety instructions from a USA Inflatables crew member. If there are no operators on any give game, the game will be stopped or deflated at anytime by a USA Inflatables crew member. Once the game can be operated safely, a USA Inflatables member will re-inflate the game and give the go ahead to begin letting riders enter the game.

8. WEATHER CONDITIONS If customer chooses to use an outdoor location, then customer must have an alternate site available in the event of inclement weather. When USA Inflatables's crew arrives to set up the decision will be made as to whether or not to set up the games outdoors. If inclement weather (any rain even drizzle) or high wind gusts above 15-20 miles per hour occurs after the games have been set up that forces the games to be shut down then USA Inflatables is not obligated to move the games to another site. Any moving of equipment after the original setup is an extra fee to be determined by the USA Inflatables team leader. If customer does not have an alternate site available and inclement weather forces a cancellation of the show then customer is still liable for the agreed Price. Due to risk management and insurance considerations, USA Inflatables's crew leader has the final say as to whether or not the games may be safely operated outdoors.

9. TRASH CANS Customer must provide trash cans near the inflatables. On asphalt this is a huge problem for our clean up crews. What happens is a kid places a can of soda on the ground at the base of the inflatable. Then accidentally, some one else immediately kicks it over spilling underneath the inflatable. Of course lots of sticky clean up is required underneath the inflatable before it can be rolled up and put back in the delivery vans. If a can of soda has been brought inside an inflatable such as the Pirates Cove, Titanic, Joust, or other similar games, and it spills and is not cleaned up immediately by customer's crew, customer will be charged a \$150 cleaning fee. This also applies to vomit or urine!

10. SPRINKLERS Sprinklers must be turned off a least one day prior to event.

11. EQUIPMENT DAMAGE Customer is held liable for any and all damages to equipment other than normal wear and tear. (Examples but not limited to: Ripped seam on an inflatable due to "overloading riders" ripped sumos, dropped radar guns, broken electronic backboards, broken welds on wacky trikes, etc) However customer is not liable for damages to equipment due to previously damaged or faulty equipment.

12. FACE PAINT Water based paints only! Believe it or not some face paint actually will rub off onto an inflatable and if is not cleaned off within 5 minutes it becomes a permanent marking!

13. ALCOHOL USA Inflatables reserves the right to refuse service to an alcohol impaired person!

14. HYSTERIA FACTOR - Our wacky interactive inflatable games make kids and teens go crazy! Literally out of control and they will not listen to attendants. For example: obstacle courses are designed for 2 players at a time to race through, then 2 more players, no more than 4 — 6 players at any time on the inflatable at once. All of the sudden 15-20 teens can literally attack the game and will not exit because as they say "others are not exiting" the inflatable, thus HYSTERIA occurs. The cause: The customer has not provided adequate attendants. Not having enough attendants is the sole reason for overloading the inflatable making it unsafe or damaging the inflatable game. If this occurs, without any warning the game will be instantly unplugged by a USA Inflatables crew member, and will deflate immediately. Once the game can be operated safely, a USA Inflatables member will give the go ahead to re-inflate the game and begin letting riders enter the game.

15. ●LIGHTING The customer must, provide lights for night events. If it is determined by a USA Inflatables team leader to be unsafe operating conditions, the ride or rides will be shut down until lighting has been secured. No exceptions. If lighting cannot be secured the games cannot be operated.

16. ●TAPE No duct tape, masking tape, or tape of any kind allowed on inflatables! If game signs and ticket signs are needed (USA Inflatables does not supply these signs) they must be placed on a chair, table, box, or on a board hammered into the ground NOT ON THE INFLATABLE. Customer will be charged a cleaning fee of \$75 per game if tape has been used.

17. ●INSURANCE USA Inflatables carries a Liability policy of \$ 1,000,000 however USA Inflatables will not be responsible for any acts of negligence on the part of the customer, their representatives or guests.

18. ●SECURITY The customer is liable for providing security.

19. ●DELAYS All delays including, but not limited to, the following: An act of nature, high winds, traffic accidents preventing delays for arrival times, access to power, lack of assistants or access to the location are the sole and complete responsibility of the customer. Delayed start time or even possible cancellation of the engagement, due to such delays then become the complete and sole liability of the customer and as such make the customer responsible for the agreed price as stated in the contract. Customer's credit can be used for a future event for up to 2 years.

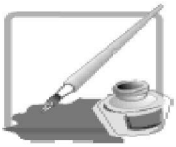
20. ●SUBSTITUTION OF ACTS USA Inflatables reserves the right to substitute one game for another of equal or better value when necessitated by circumstances beyond their control, e.g. damage to an item in such a way as to cause the item to be unsafe to operate, (or will not operate) 'blower failures, an inflatable with a large ripped or open seam making equipment unusable, etc..... without a change in the agreed price. If customer prefers to accept a credit towards a future event, USA Inflatables will agree to issue such credit for any game not operated as contracted, however customer must pay this contract in full.

21. ● PERMITS, LICENCES, INSPECTIONS Customer is responsible to obtain and pay for all permits, licenses, fire/mechanical inspections, etc., required by legal authority to operate rented items at the customer's event. The customer agrees to hold USA Inflatables harmless for the customer's failure to do so, or for USA Inflatables not being permitted to operate by an agency with such legal authority.

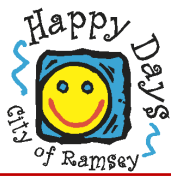


Photo Contest Rules

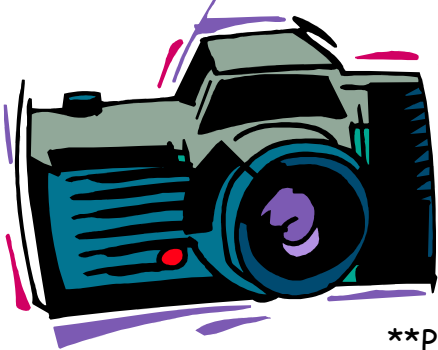

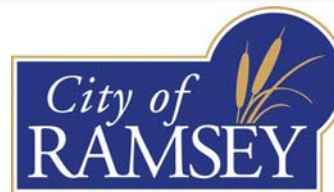

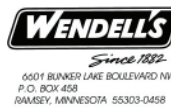
