RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH OPUS 21 FOR UTILITY BILLING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey currently owns, operates and maintains its own utility systems; and

WHEREAS, the costs in conjunction with providing those utility systems are born by the uses through payment of utility billings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey currently uses the services of OPUS 21 to bill utility services on a quarterly basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey has been in a contract relationship with OPUS 21 From February 7, 2008 with the scheduled ending date of February 6, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to extend the contract with OPUS 21 for the period of February 7, 2013 through February 6, 2016, with two one-year renewal options which could extend the contract through February 6, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a three-year billing agreement with OPUS 21 effective February 7, 2013 with the addition of two one-year renewal options.
