**RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTIAL PAYMENT TO NORTH VALLEY INC FOR CITY
PROJECT 12-23,
ALPINE DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION**

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2012 the Ramsey City Council accepted the plans and authorized the solicitation of bids; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement for bids for Improvement Project 12-23; Alpine Drive Reconstruction, bids were received, opened and tabulated according to law; and

WHEREAS, North Valley Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, as of April 23, 2013 \$272,033.27 has been paid to date; and

WHEREAS, Civil Engineer II has inspected the completed work and recommends partial payment to North Valley Inc. in the amount of \$18,525.74.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:**

- 1) That the City Council hereby authorizes partial payment to North Valley Inc. for Improvement Project 12-23; Alpine Drive Reconstruction in the amount of \$18,525.74.
- 2) That the City Council hereby accepts the project and authorizes the Mayor or City Administrator to sign the release form for this payment.
- 3) That the total amount of this payment is not included in resolutions approving payment of bills for the date of April 23, 2013.
- 4) That the City of Ramsey Finance Department will be provided a signed copy of this resolution.
