**RESOLUTION ORDERING PREPARATION OF FEASIBILITY REPORT FOR
JARVIS STREET RECONSTRUCTION AND RAILROAD QUIET ZONE
IMPROVEMENTS; CITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT #15-20**

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey, in partnership with the City of Elk River, proposes to reconstruct Garnet Street between Trunk Highway 10 and 165th Avenue, and to assess the benefitted properties for all or a portion of the cost of the improvements, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ramsey, in partnership with the City of Elk River, proposes to reconstruct the Garnet Street Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroad crossing to allow it to be designated as a quiet zone.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAMSEY, ANOKA COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, as follows:

That the proposed improvements, designated as Improvement Project No. 15-20, be referred to the City Engineer for study and that the City Engineer is instructed to report to the Council with all convenient speed advising the Council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvements are necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether they should best be made as proposed or in conjunction with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvements as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.
